
## Disorders of the Endocrine System

- **3.** Condition in which your thyroid gland produces too much of the hormone thyroxine
- **8.** Medical condition where too much aldosterone is produced by the adrenal glands
- **12.** An abnormal enlargement of your thyroid gland
- **13.** Condition of severely stunted physical and mental growth owing to untreated congenital deficiency of thyroid hormone
- **14.** Condition characterized by an abnormally low level of blood sugar
- **16.** Condition that affects the development of a child's genitals and reproductive organs

- **17.** Disorder that occurs when your body produces insufficient amounts of certain hormones produced by your adrenal glands

- 1. Dwarfism caused by a lack of growth hormone, usually due to malfunction of the pituitary gland
- **2.** Disorder in which the parathyroid glands in your neck produce too much parathyroid hormone

- **5.** Abnormal growth due to an excess of growth hormone during childhood
- **6.** Hypersecretion of adrenal cortex hormones causing increased blood glucose

- **10.** Medical term for a high blood sugar
- **11.** Condition marked by intermittent muscular spasms, caused by malfunction of the parathyroid glands
