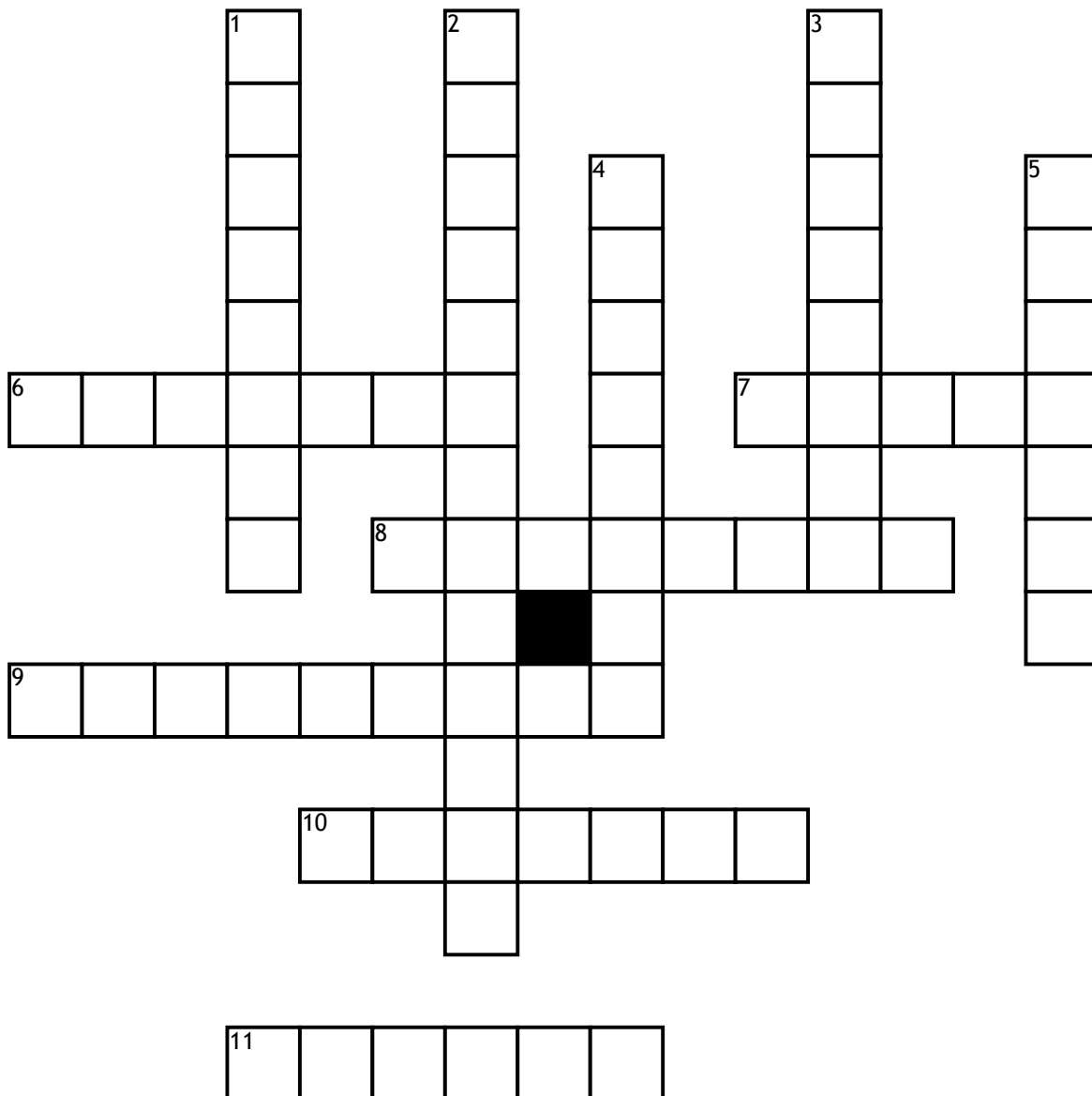

7. A scar along the edge of a plant seed marking where the seed was attached to the ovary wall.
8. Pieces of stems and roots that are cut from plant and used to grow new plants.
9. A stem like area in plants between the cotyledons and radicle.
10. A state of decreased metabolism.
11. An offspring produced by a sexual production.

1. A technique in which a portion of one plant is inserted into and grows with the root or shoot of another.
2. The growing of living cells in a controlled medium.
3. The process of causing roots to form on a stem.
4. The stem above the cotyledons.
5. The structure composed of the epicotyl plus any embryonic leaves.
