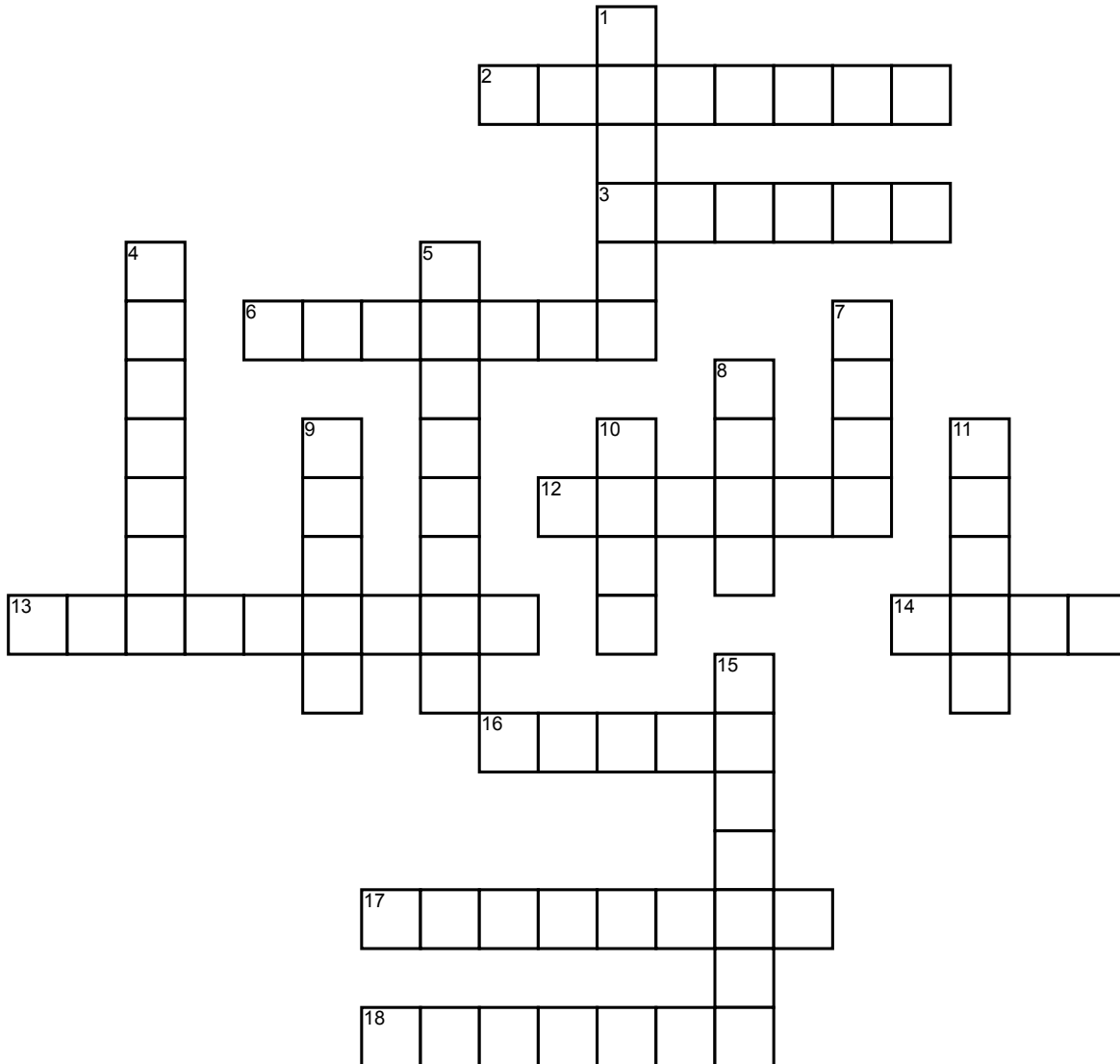

18. used for precision cutting and slicing; used to open the flesh/skin; may also help to remove out of body cavities - sharp

4. used for grasping, pulling, compressing, or holding tissue and organs of specimen
