4. Searches for a value in the top row of a table or an array of values, and then returns a value in the same column from a row you specify in the table or array
5. Returns a custom result when a formula generates an error, and a standard result when no error is detected
6. This formula will return a value from an array corresponding to the index number provided.
7. Returns the count of cells that meet one or more criteria
8. joins information from different cells

## Down

1. Multiplies ranges or arrays together and returns the sum of products
2. Returns a cell or range of cells that is a specified number of rows and columns from a cell or range of cells
3. Extracts a substring from a string (starting at any position)
4. Performs a logical test and returns one value for a TRUE result, and another for a FALSE result
5. Calculates the Net Present Value for a schedule of cash flows that is not necessarily periodic
