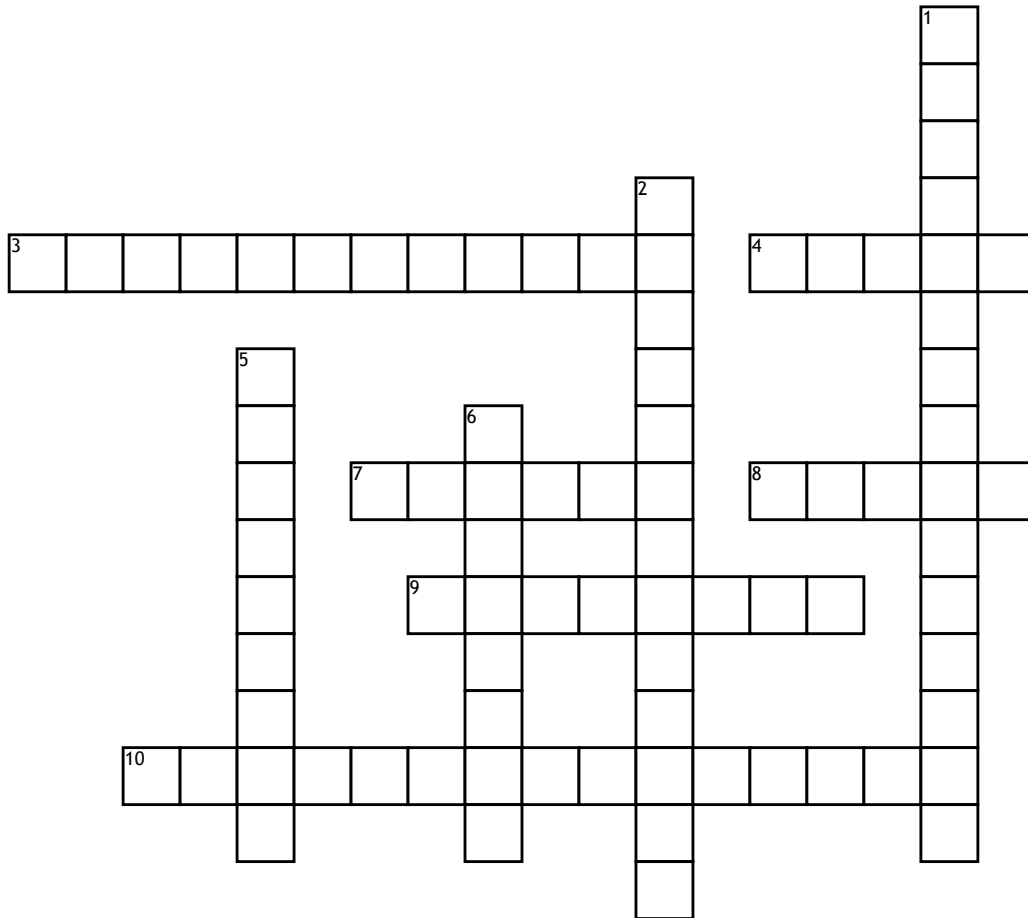


# Dog Breeds



## Across

3. used on the ranch, typically black and white with long hair, herding breed  
 4. one of Americas top dog breeds, fun loving, energetic, silly in nature, part of the Working group  
 7. bred to hunt in packs, smaller, friendly dog that enjoys company, part of the Hound group  
 8. originated in Japan, noted for protective qualities, have a very curly tail and thick hair, part of the working group  
 9. Powerful dogs, originated in China, have a blackish-blue tongue, part of the Non-sporting group

10. part of the working group, typically used for pulling sleds, bulkier than Husky

## Down

1. often considered a family dog, also used for bird hunting, longer hair coat with feathered legs and tail, Sporting group  
 2. long hair, typically grey and white, resembles an Old English Sheepdog, part of the Herding group  
 5. White with black spots, starred in a major Disney classic with Cruella De'ville, Non-sporting group  
 6. short legs, can be smooth, rough or wire haired, often called a 'weiner', part of the Hound group
