
Dog Breeds

- **3.** used on the ranch, typically black and white with long hair, herding breed
- **4.** one of Americas top dog breeds, fun loving, energetic, silly in nature, part of the Working group
- 7. bred to hunt in packs, smaller, friendly dog that enjoys company, part of the Hound group
- **8.** orginated in Japan, noted for protective qualities, have a very curly tail and thick hair, part of the working group
- **9.** Powerful dogs, orginated in China, have a blackish-blue tongue, part of the Non-sporting group

10. part of the working group, typically used for pulling sleds, bulkier than Husky

Down

- 1. often considered a family dog, also used for bird hunting, longer hair coat with feathered legs and tail, Sporting group
- 2. long hair, typically grey and white, resembles an Old English Sheepdog, part of the Herding group
- **5.** White with black spots, starred in a major Disney classic with Cruella De'ville, Non-sporting group
- **6.** short legs, can be smooth, rough or wire haired, often called a 'weiner', part of the Hound group
