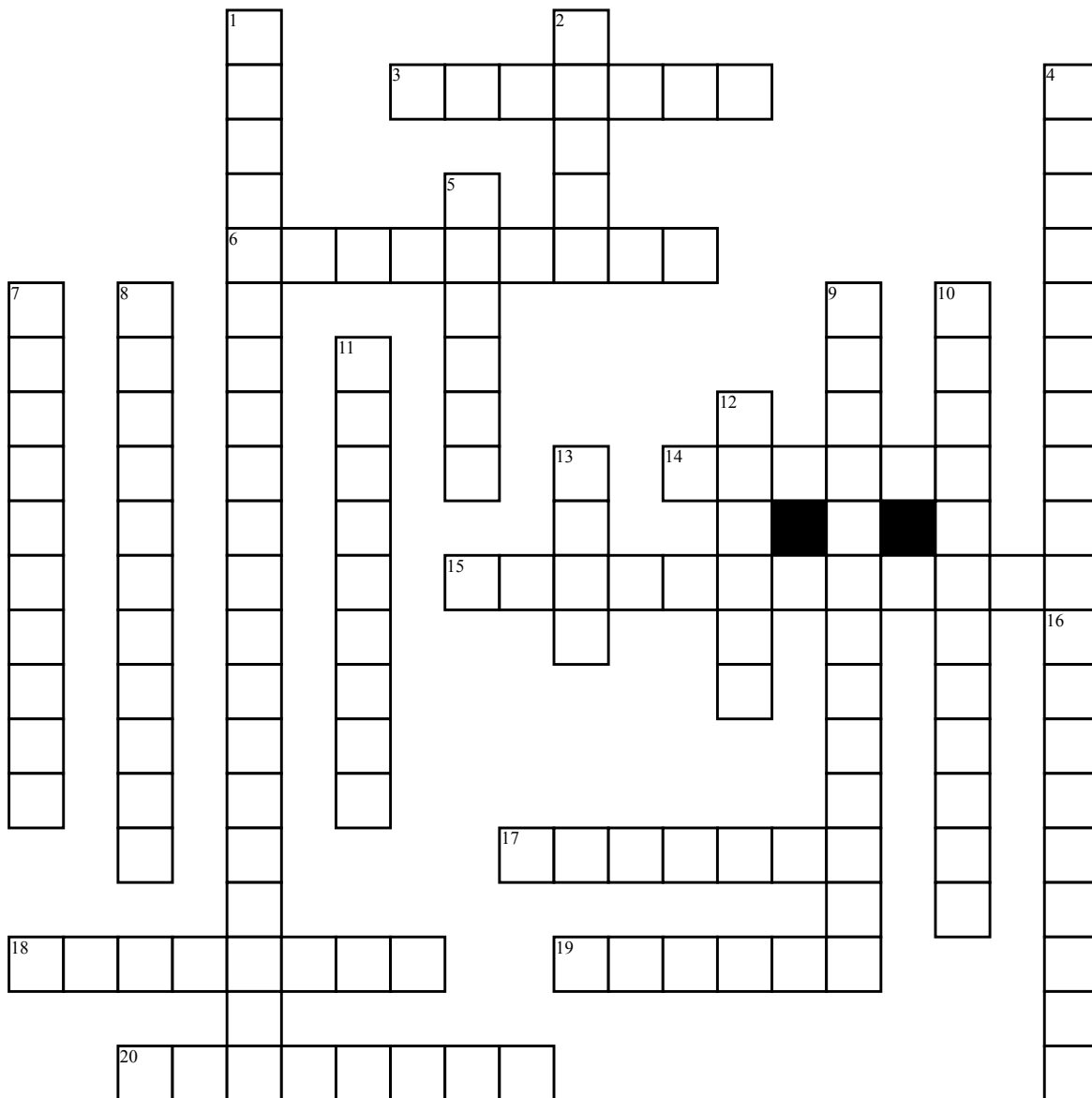


Double Identity Crossword
