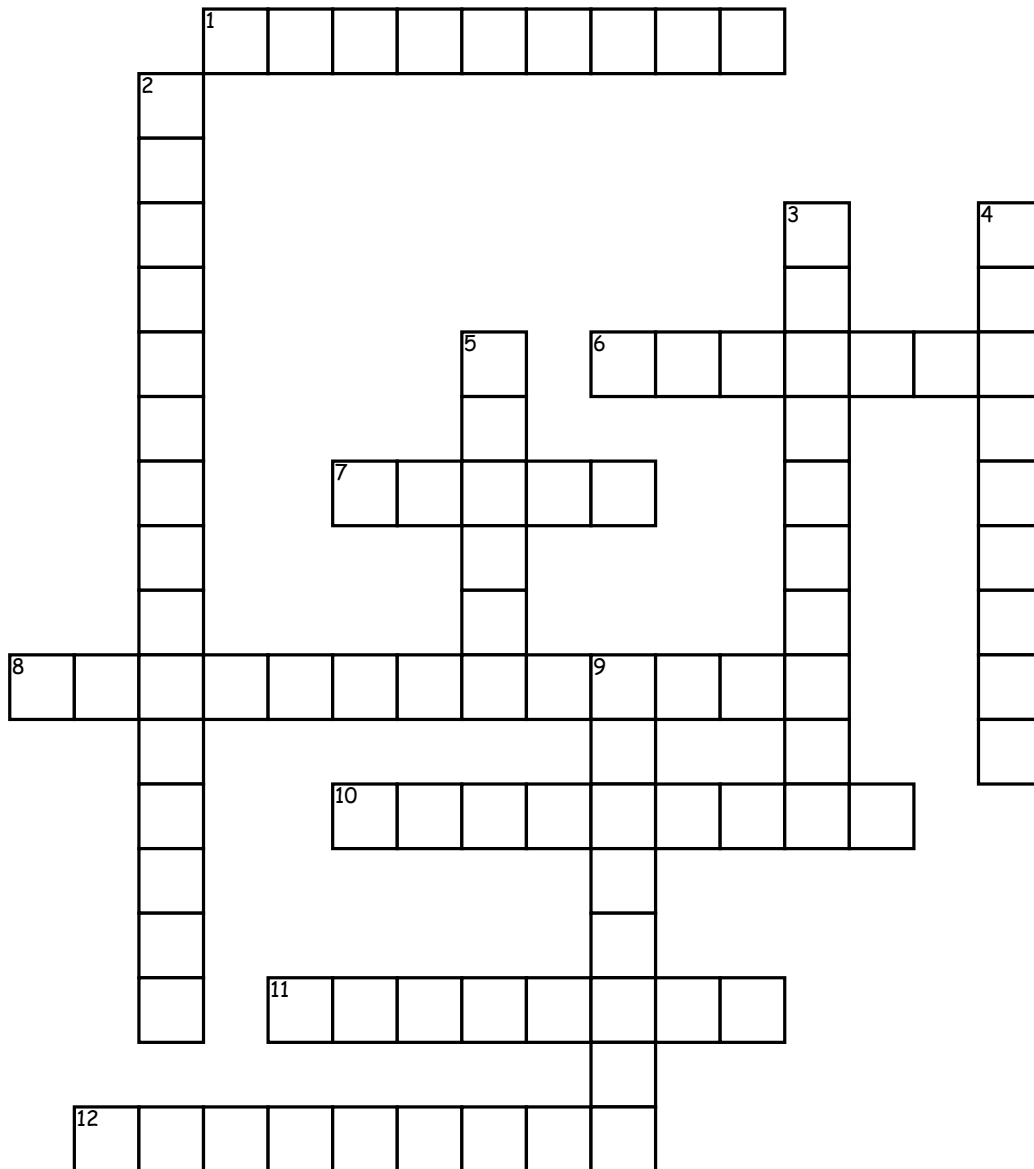


# Drainage Basin Characteristics



## **Across**

1. A smaller stream/river which feeds into a larger river channel
6. What a river (water) flows in
7. Where the river ends and meets the sea
8. The area of land drained by a river and its tributaries

10. The boundary between one drainage basin and another

11. When large rocks are pushed along the river bed

12. Rocks smashing into each other breaking them down into smaller fragments

## **Down**

2. The force of water pushing air into cracks and wearing the rock away

3. The point where two rivers meet

4. When pebble sized rocks are bounced along the river bed

5. Where the river starts, often a spring or a lake

9. When rocks rub against the river channel, wearing it away
