
Drainage Basin Characteristics

- 8. The area of land drained by a river and its tributaries

- 10. The boundary between one drainage basin and another
- 11. When large rocks are pushed along the river bed
- 12. Rocks smashing into each other breaking them down into smaller fragments

2. The force of water pushing air into cracks and wearing the rock away

- 3. The point where two rivers meet
- 4. When pebble sized rocks are bounced along the river bed
- 5. Where the river starts, often a spring or a lake
- 9. When rocks rub against the river channel, wearing it away
