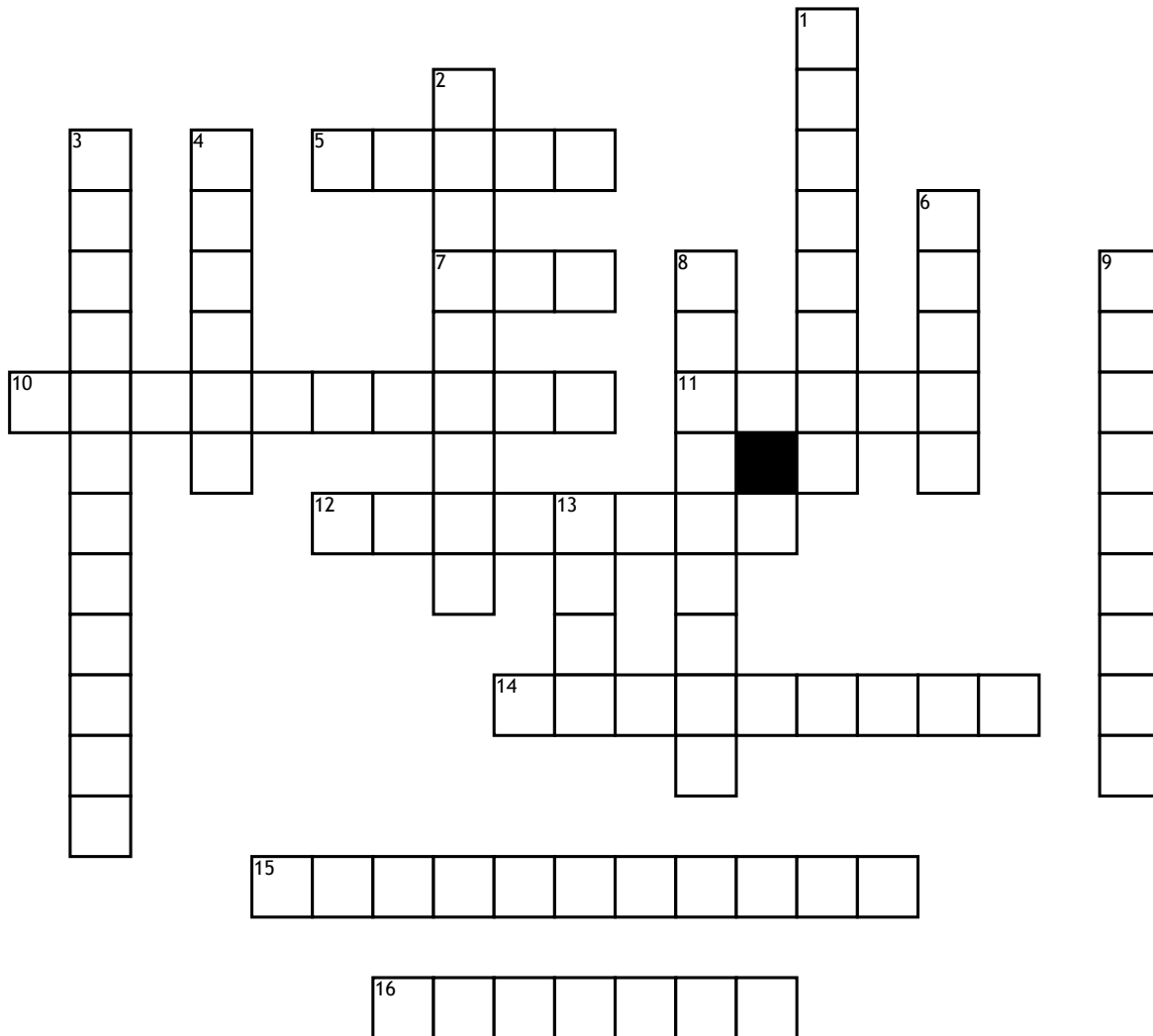

1. Refers to all the predetermined physical traffic or movement of the actors on the stage, including entrances, exits, placement of actors, props, and set pieces
 2. An electronic object that actually works on stage (lamps, coffee pots, telephone)

3. Any electronic object only used for decoration, that does not function

4. A type of theatre where the stage juts into the audience
