
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## Drama Test 4 Vocabulary



## Across

- 2. Imaginary "wall" that takes up the rest of the space in which the play takes place. It is the place where the audience is.
- 3. Controllers that are used to gradually bring the lights up or down
- **4.** Curtains that hang straight down on the right and left of the stage
- **9.** Area between the stage and the front row of seats
- **12.** Staging set up in which the audience sits on all four sides of the playing area

- **13.** Part of the stage that protrudes out from the proscenium
- **14.** The pattern of movement that an actor follows
- **15.** Stage in which the audience sits on 3 sides of the acting area
- **16.** Canvas covered wooden frame used to create scenery
- **17.** Auditorium in which the floor slopes away from the stage so that the audience members can more easily see the stage

## Down

1. Stage with an architectural arch that forms the front of the stage

- **5.** Painted curtain without folds that gives the illusion of a 3-D set
- **6.** Rod suspended over the stage from which lights and scenery are hung
- **7.** Seating within the auditorium
- **8.** A set of drapery for concealing all parts of the stage from the view of the audience
- **10.** The environment of the play including scenery and furniture
- 11. Offstage to the left and right of the acting area
