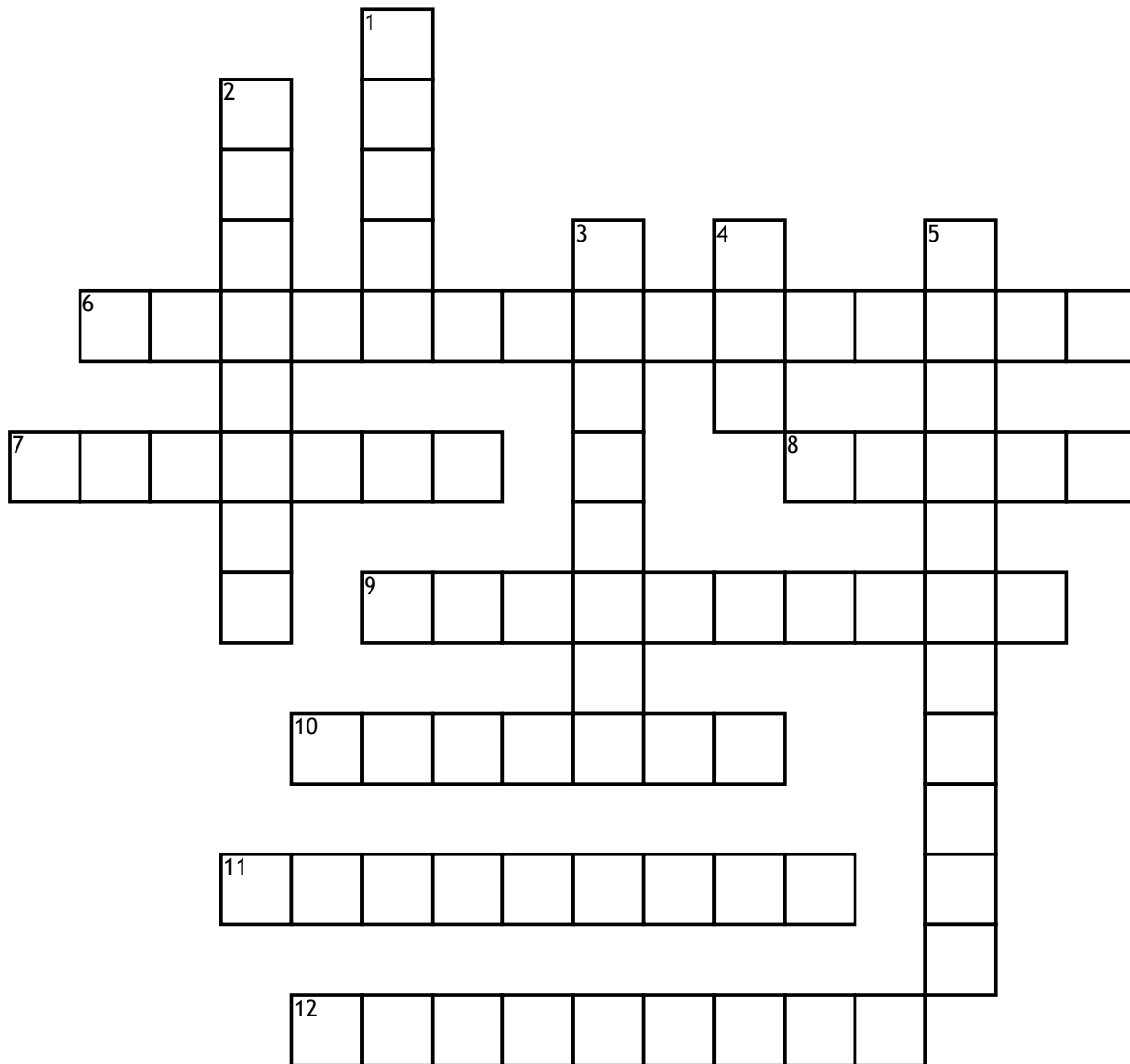

## Across

6. tells actors what to do  
 7. in a play it dominates the audience's experience of the drama. It quite forms the backdrop for the action
