

1. psychopharmaceutical, or psychotropic is a chemical substance that changes brain function and results in alterations in perception, mood, or consciousness

2. a secondary, typically undesirable effect of a drug or medical treatment.

3. a potent central nervous system stimulant that is used in the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, narcolepsy, and obesity

4. is a pharmaceutical drug that legally requires a medical prescription to be dispensed.

5. the habitual taking of addictive or illegal drugs.

6. any of a class of sedative and sleep-inducing drugs derived from barbituric acid.

10. synthetic drug with more rapid and lasting effects than amphetamine, used illegally as a stimulant and as a prescription drug to treat narcolepsy and maintain blood pressure.
