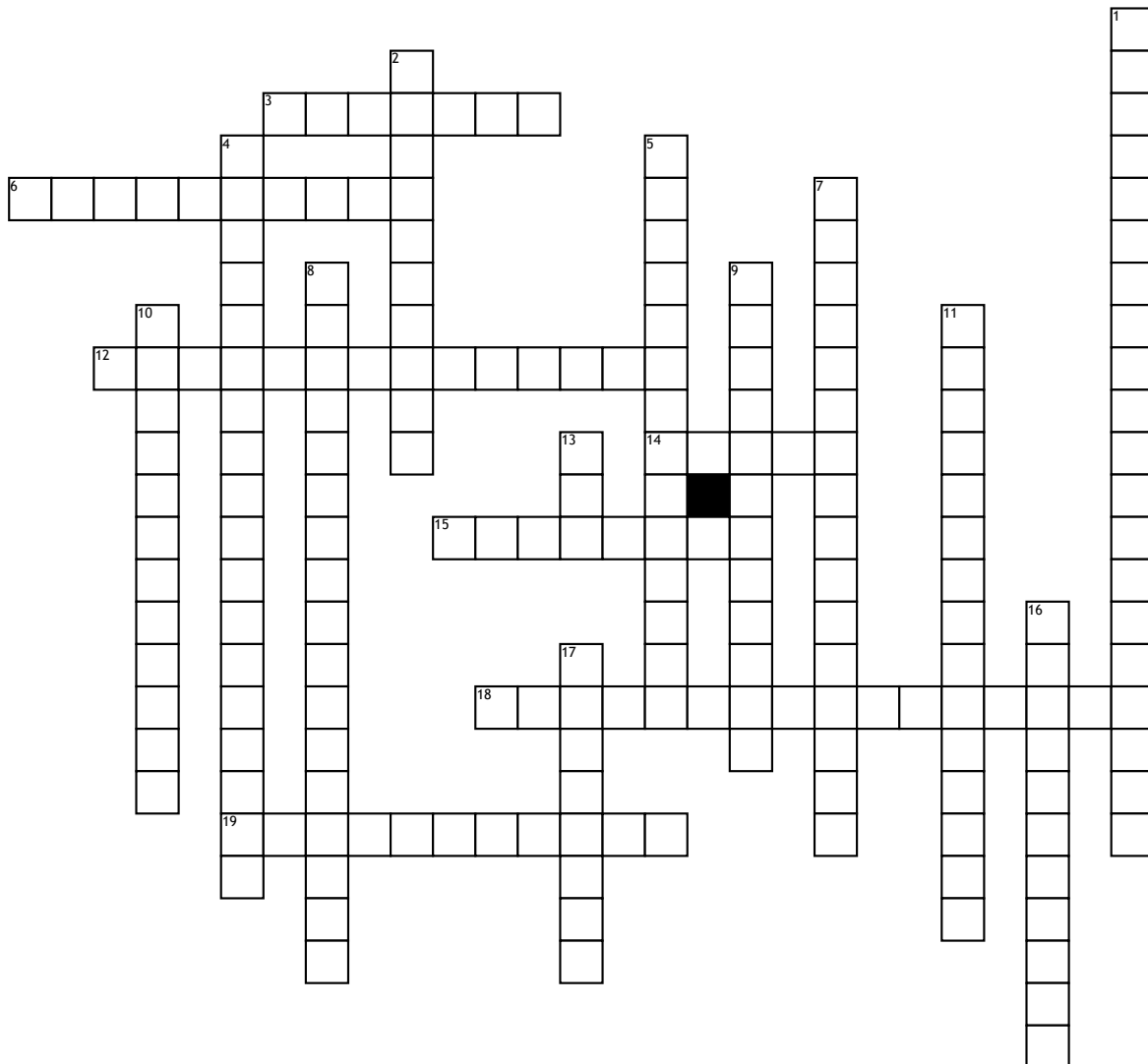

1. changes in manufacturing and transportation that began with fewer things being made by hand but instead made using machines in larger-scale factories
2. Location factors related to the costs of factors of production inside the plant, such as land, labor, and capital.
4. any of several simple gaseous compounds that contain carbon, chlorine, fluorine, and sometimes hydrogen
5. A complex chemical and atmospheric phenomenon that occurs when emissions of sulfur and nitrogen compounds and other substances are transformed by chemical processes in the atmosphere and then deposited on earth in either wet or dry form
7. Air pollution produced by the action of sunlight on hydrocarbons, nitrogen oxides, and other pollutants.

8. precipitation, as rain, snow, or sleet, containing relatively high concentrations of acid-forming chemicals
9. the presence in or introduction into the air of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects
10. is a company that allows factories to be largely duty free and tariff free
