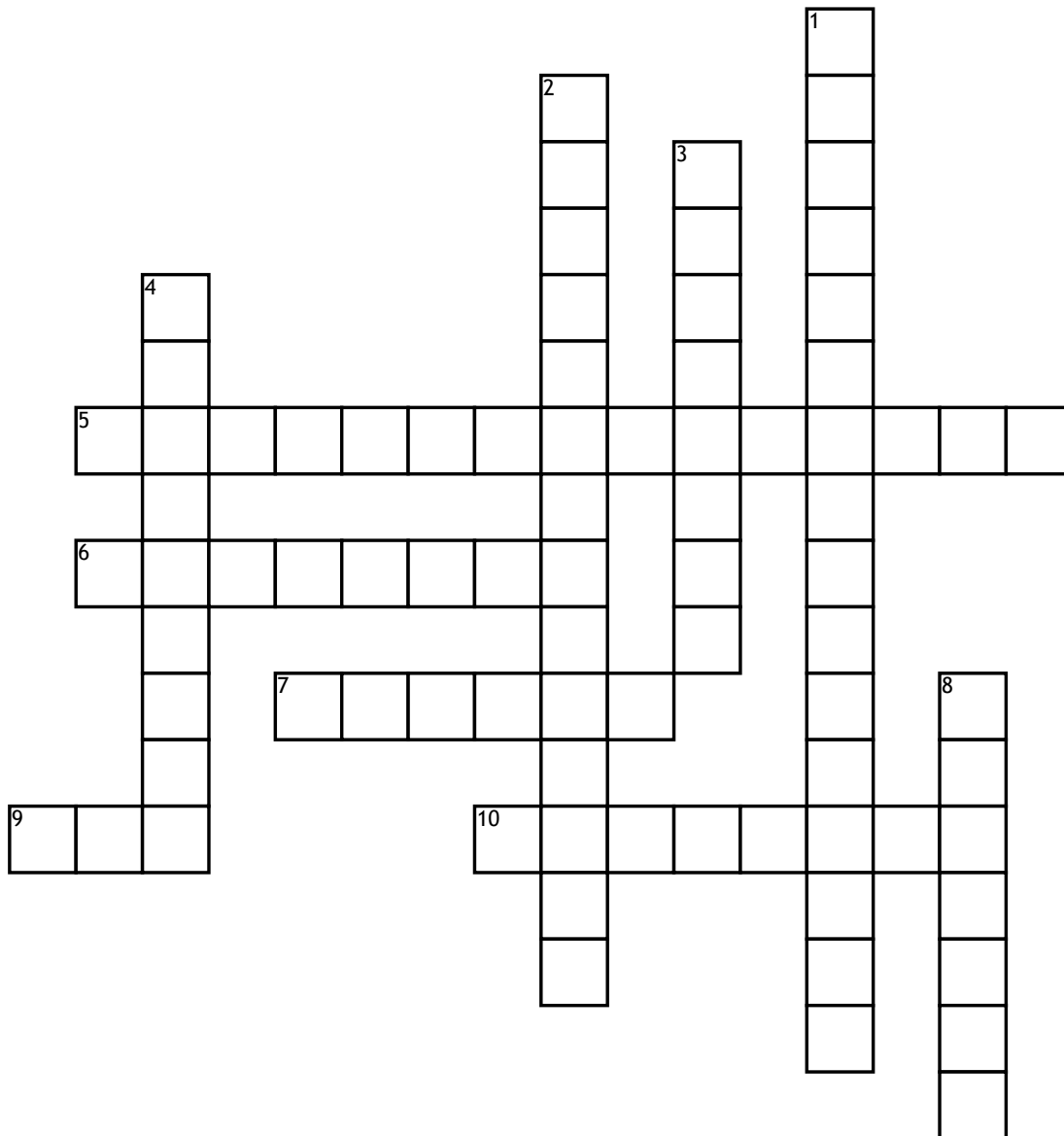

5. A form of arteriosclerosis in which a buildup of yellowish plaques of cholesterol, lipids and cellular debris inside of the arteries decreasing the size of the lumen
6. Distortion or fuzziness of an image sometimes found in ECG's
7. spasmodic, choking, and/or suffocative pain
9. Occurs when the central venous pressure is increased
10. cardiac arrest; absence of a heartbeat

1. Hardening and thickening of the arterial walls
2. Abnormal narrowing of contraction of a body passage or opening
3. Insufficient supply of blood to an organ, usually due to a blocked artery
4. Force or resistance the heart must pump against to eject blood. Produced by tone of vascular system
8. volume of blood in ventricle at the end of diastole
