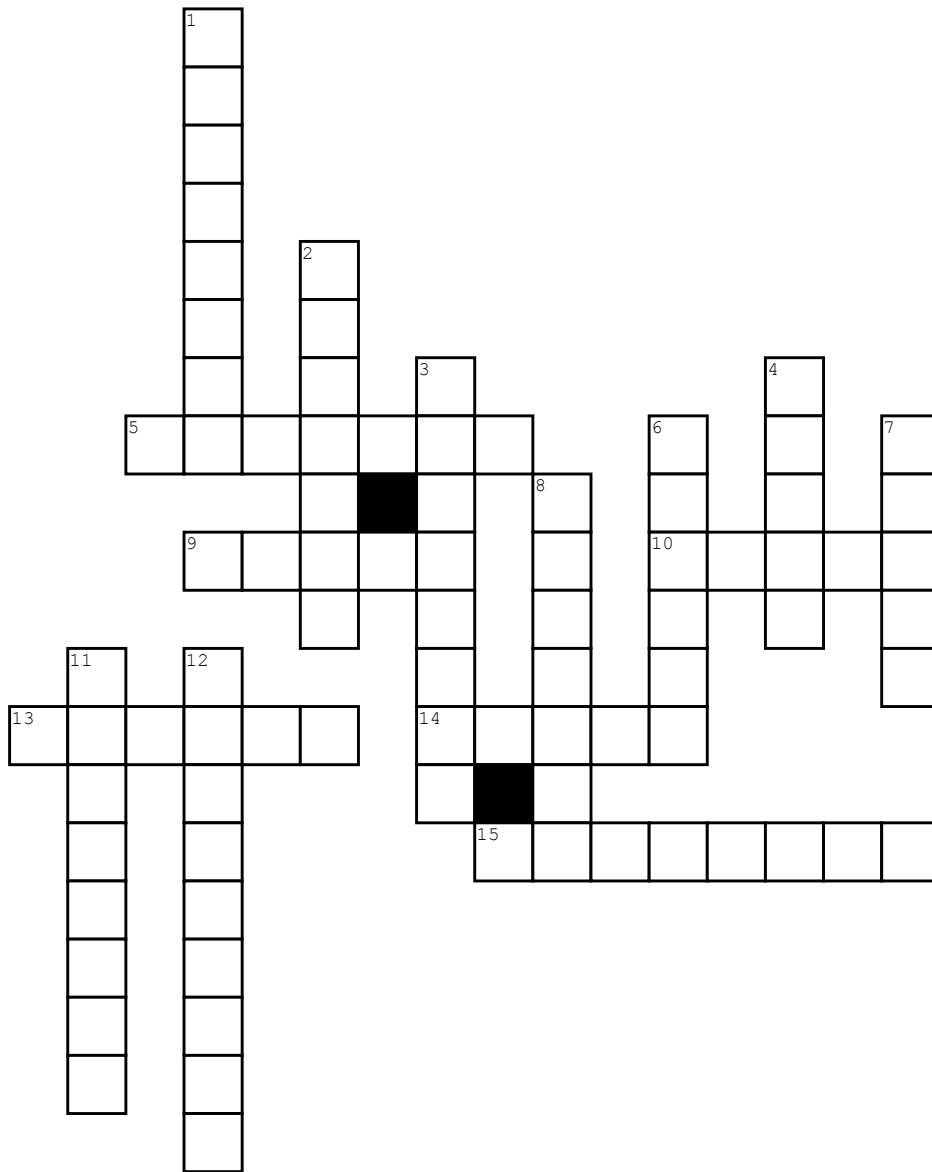

- 5.** a contagious bacterial disease characterized by fever and delirium, typically with the formation of buboes (see bubonic plague) and sometimes infection of the lungs
- 9.** a windlass for raising ore or water from a mine
- 10.** (especially in England and Wales) a unit of land, originally a feudal lordship, consisting of a lord's demesne and lands rented to tenants.
- 13.** May 1, celebrated in many countries as a traditional springtime festival or as an international day honoring workers

- 14.** buy and sell goods and services

- 15.** suffer death, typically in a violent, sudden, or untimely way
