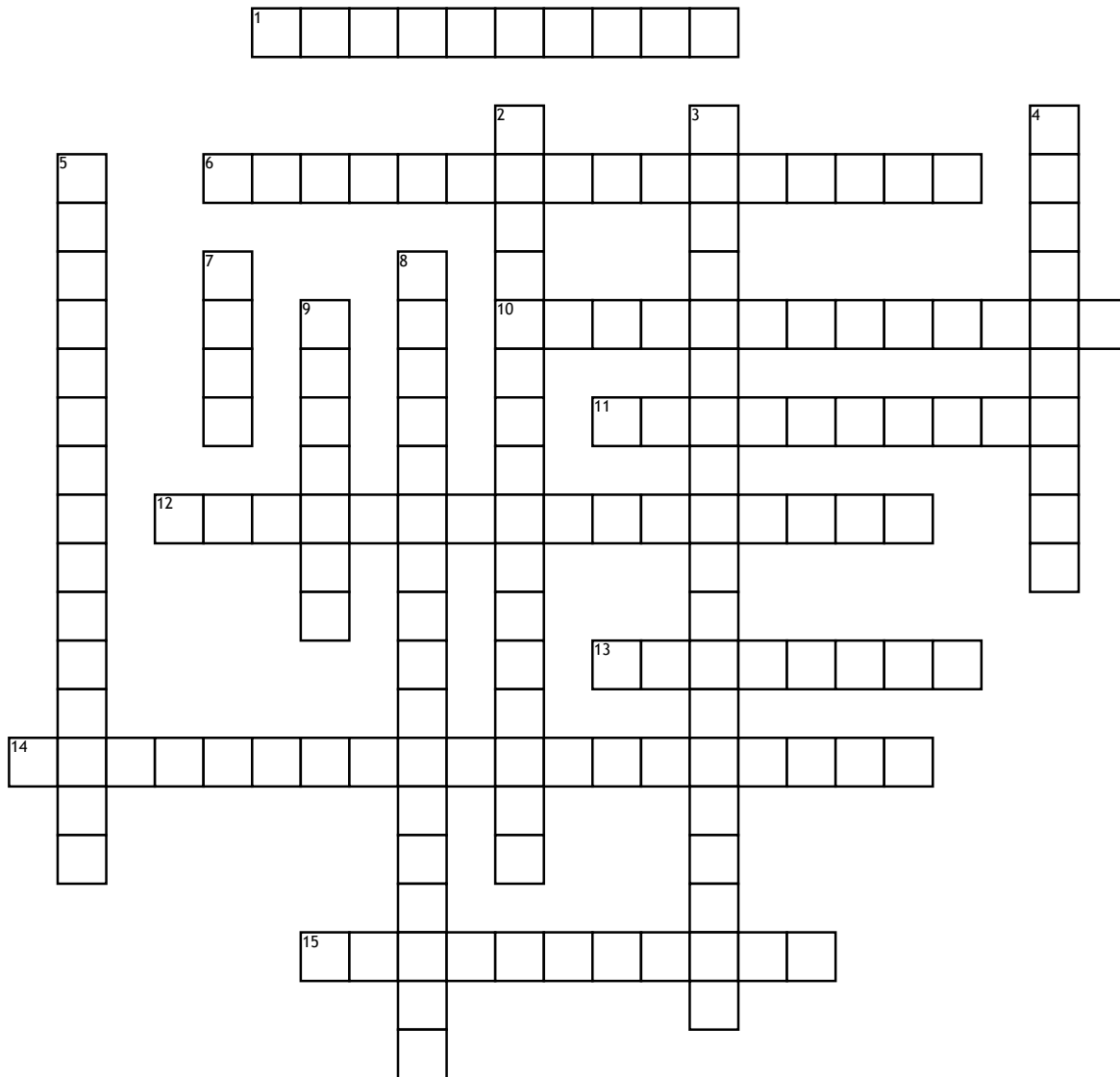


# END OF THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR
