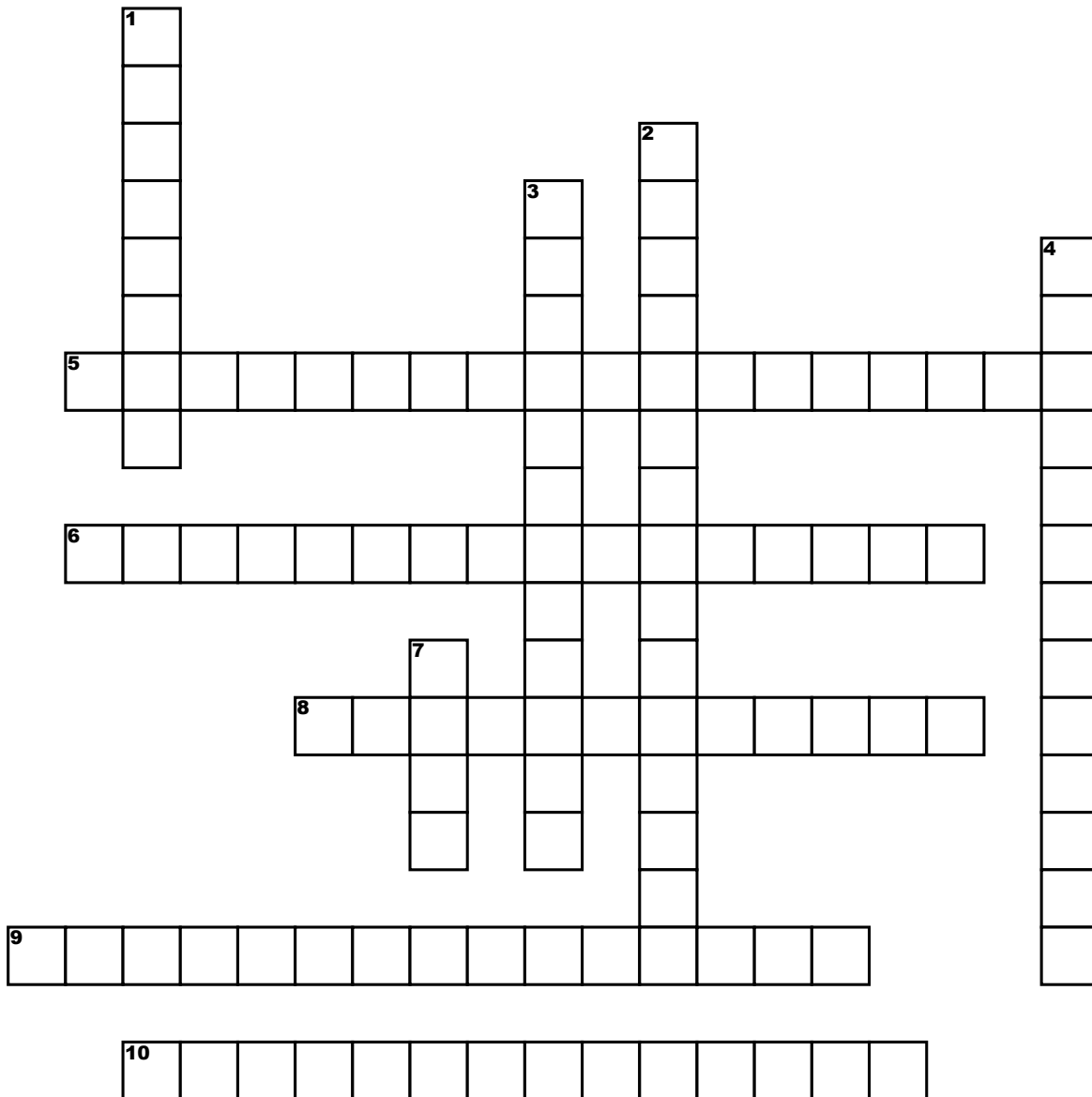

8. educator and president of Morehouse college; mentored Martin Luther King jr.

9. first two african american students admitted to UGA

10. first african american mayor of a major southern city in 1973; expanded the Atlanta airport and was mayor of Atlanta during the 1996 Summer Olympic Games

1. symbol of Georgia; changed to incorporate St. Andrews Cross, became a problem

2. 14 member committee; studied the problem of integration after Brown v. Board of education

3. only white citizens were allowed to vote in primary elections

4. segregationist Georgia govenor that promised to bring back white primary but failed; big supporter of education; expanded school year to 9 months

7. student organization founded to help black citizens register to vote and led by protest, sit-ins, and boycotts
