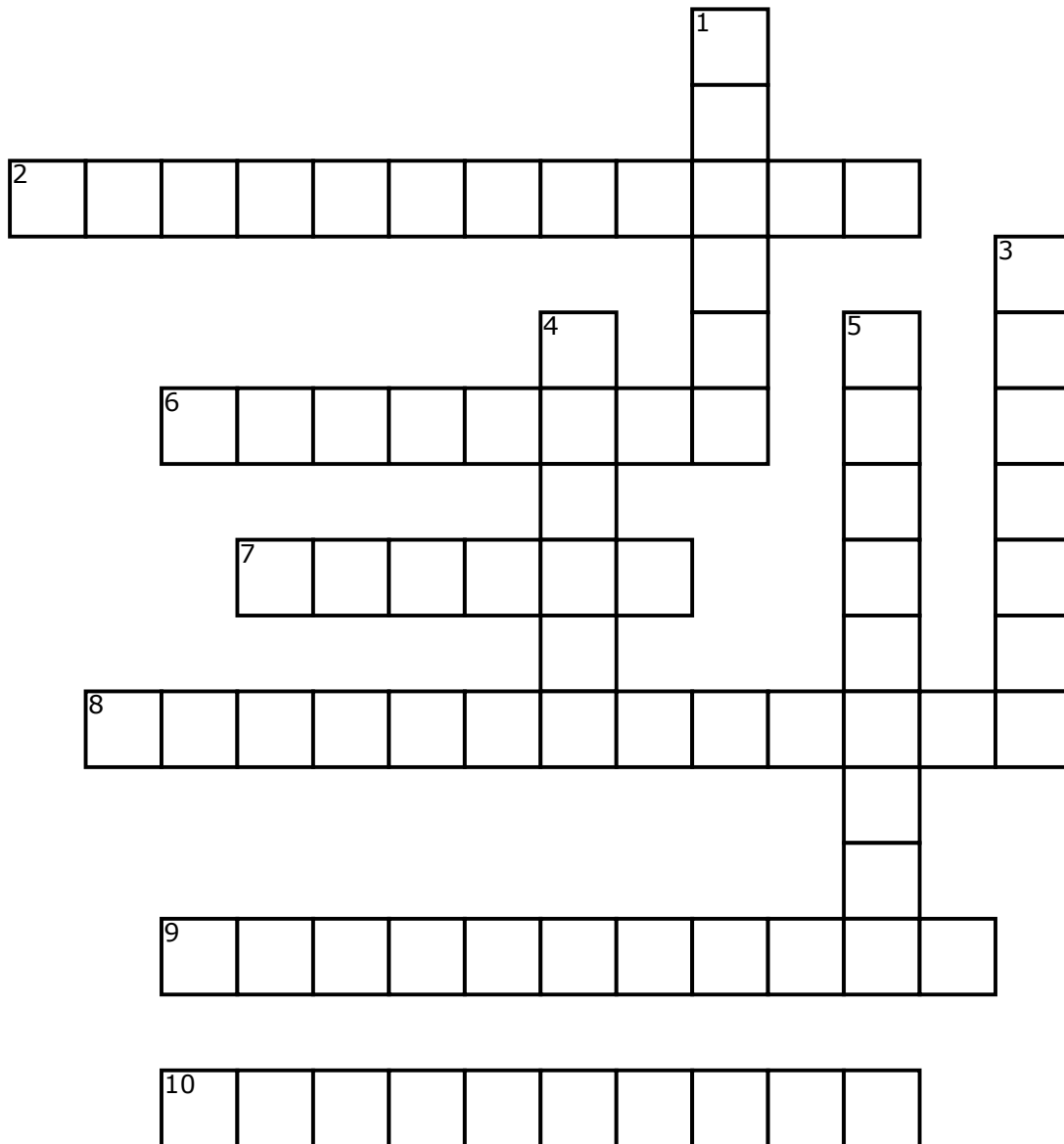

9. Irregularly curved cornea or lens, that causes the eye to not be able to focus properly

1. The tough, white part of the eye.

3. A thin structure that lines the inside of the sclera.

4. A transparent tissue that bends and focuses light before it enters the lens.
