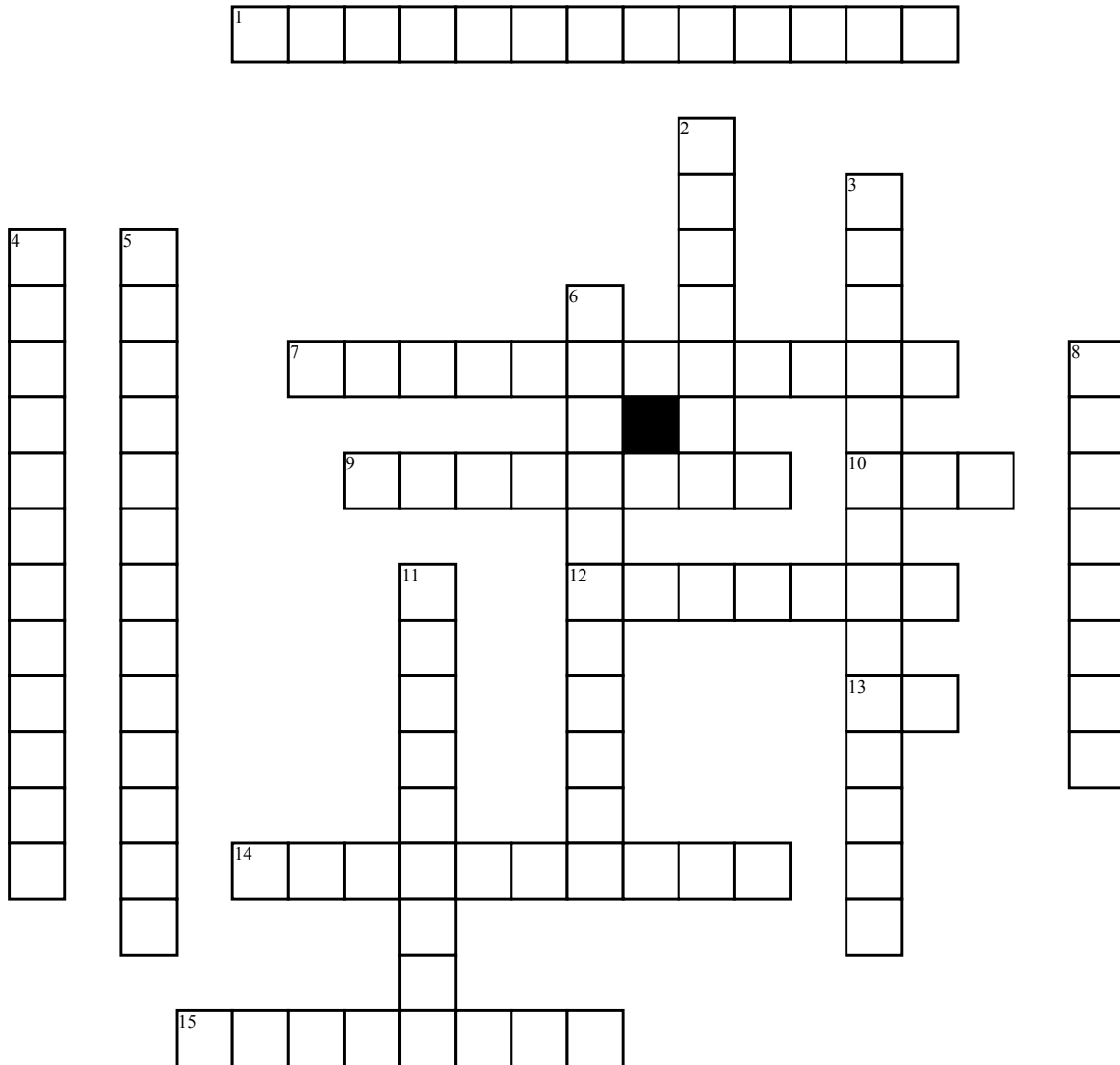


Early Childhood Cognitive Development
