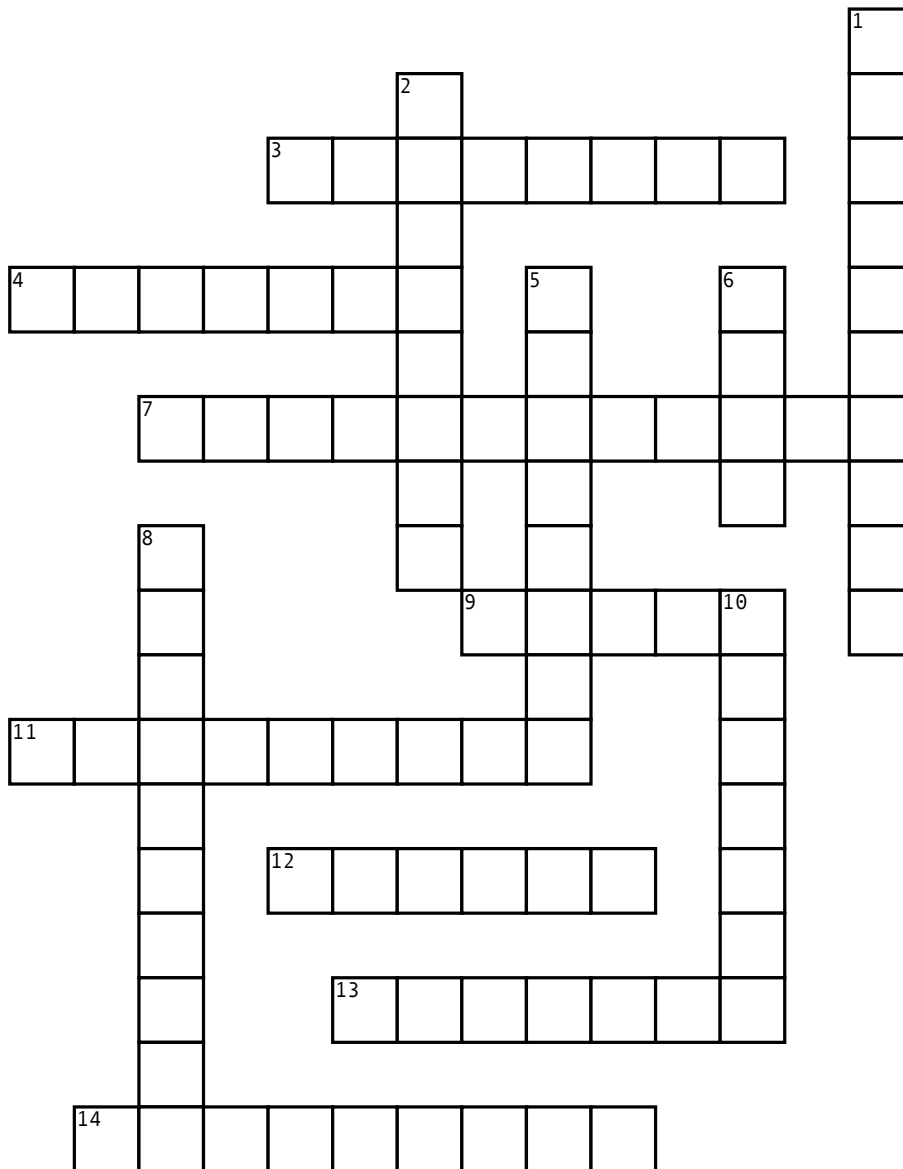


Early Times: Health and Medicine
