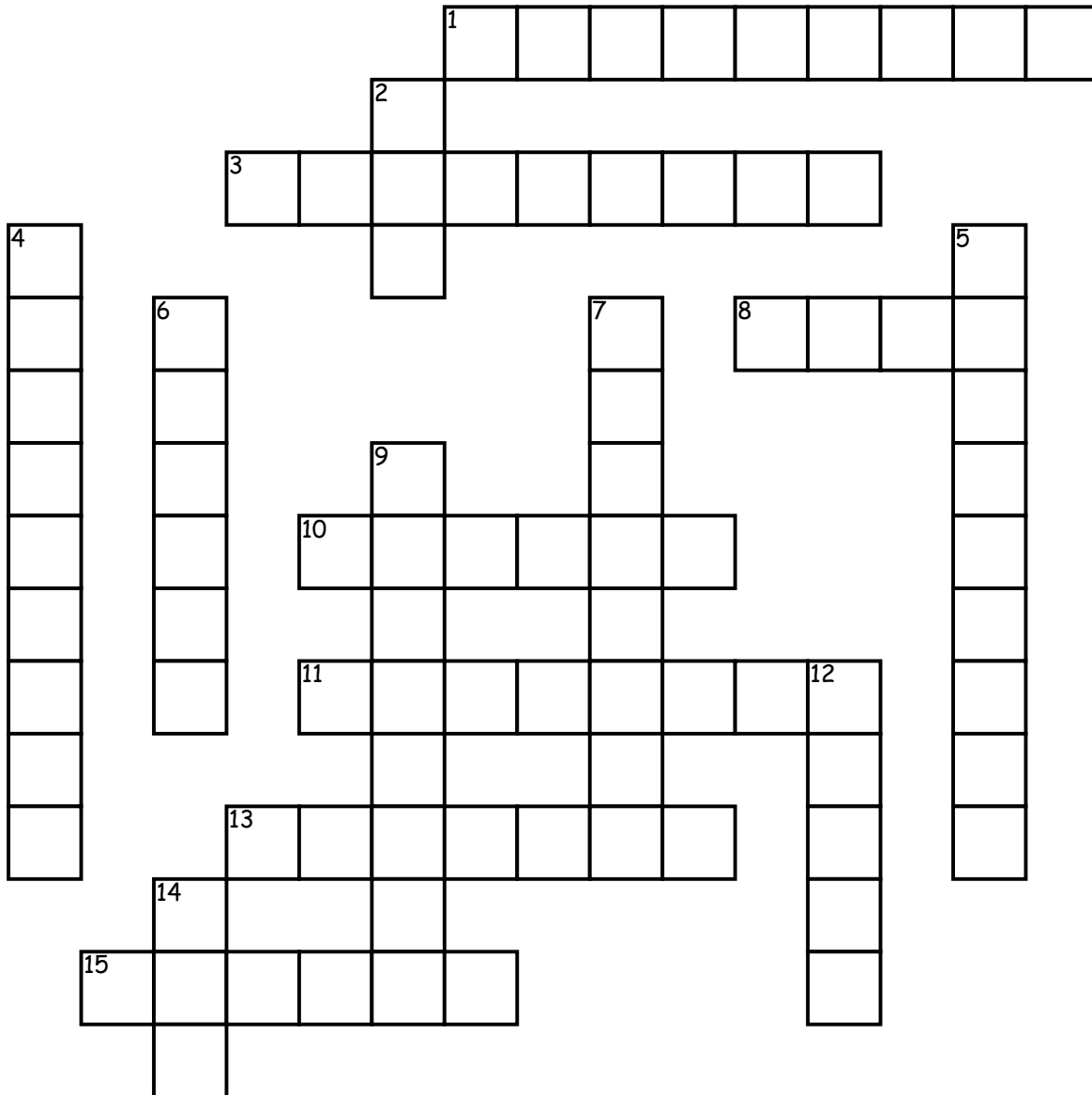


Earning Money
