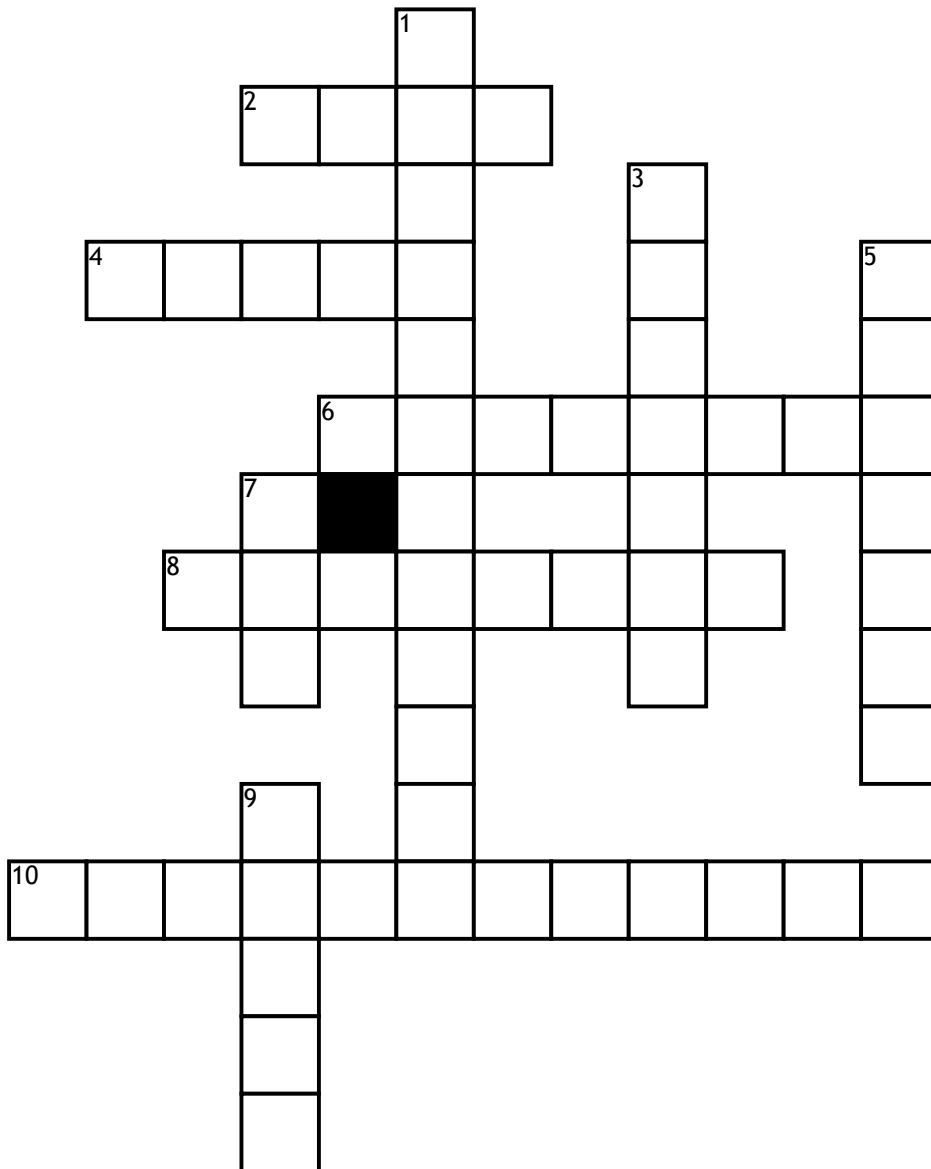

## Across

2. This body during a particular lunar month, or during a certain period of time, regarded as a distinct object or entity.

4. The complete or perfect shadow of an opaque body, as a planet, where the direct light from the source of illumination is completely cut off.

6. The partial or imperfect shadow outside the complete shadow of an opaque body, as a planet, where the light from the source of illumination is only partly cut off.

8. The moon when the whole of its disk is illuminated, occurring when in opposition to the sun.

10. An eclipse in which the moon appears darkened as it passes into the Earth's shadow.

## Down

1. A type of eclipse that occurs when the moon passes between the sun and the earth, and the moon partially or fully blocks the sun.

3. The moon either when in conjunction with the sun or soon after, being either invisible or visible only as a slender crescent.

5. A dark figure or image cast on the ground or some surface by a body intercepting light.

7. The sun that is the central body of the solar system, around which the planets revolve and from which they receive light and heat.

9. The planet third in order from the sun.
