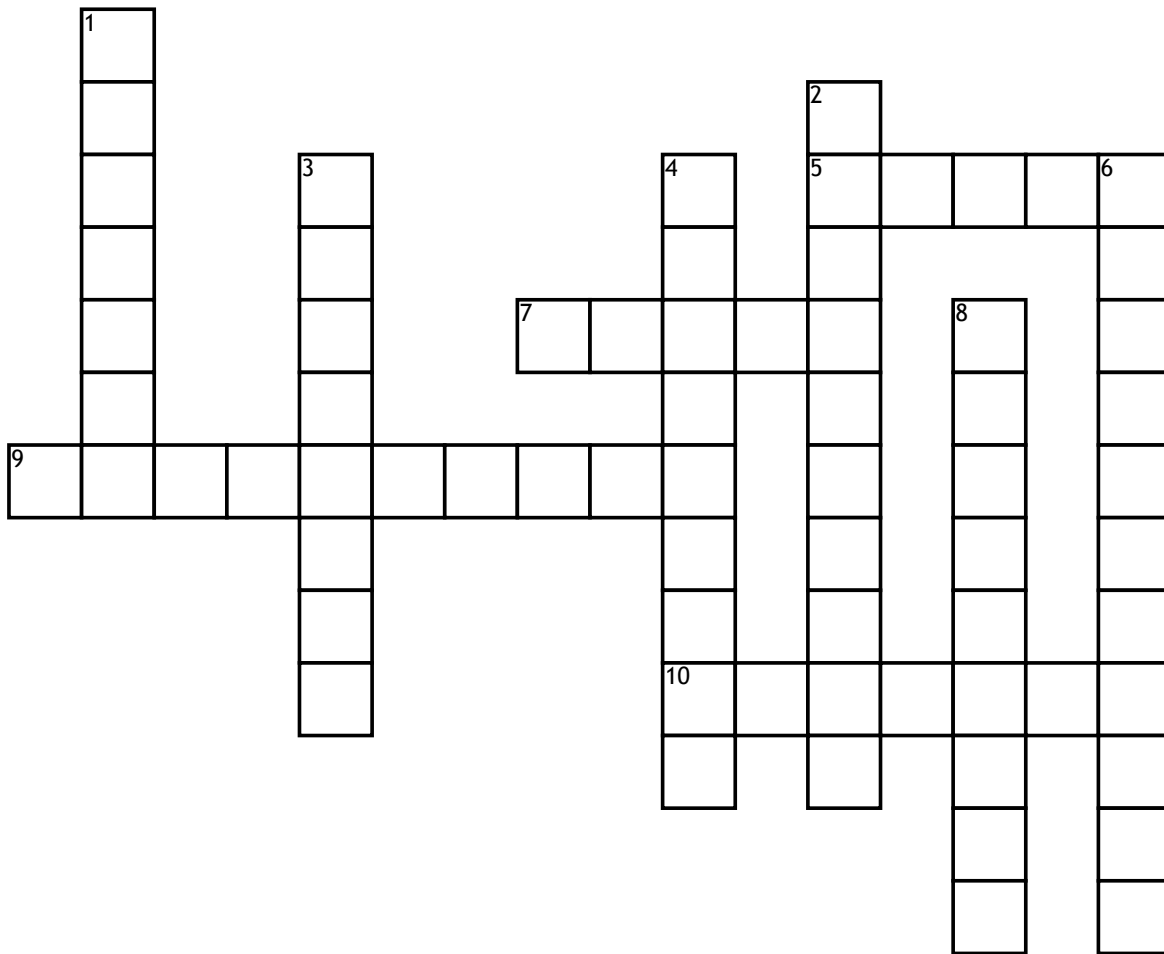


# Earthquakes
