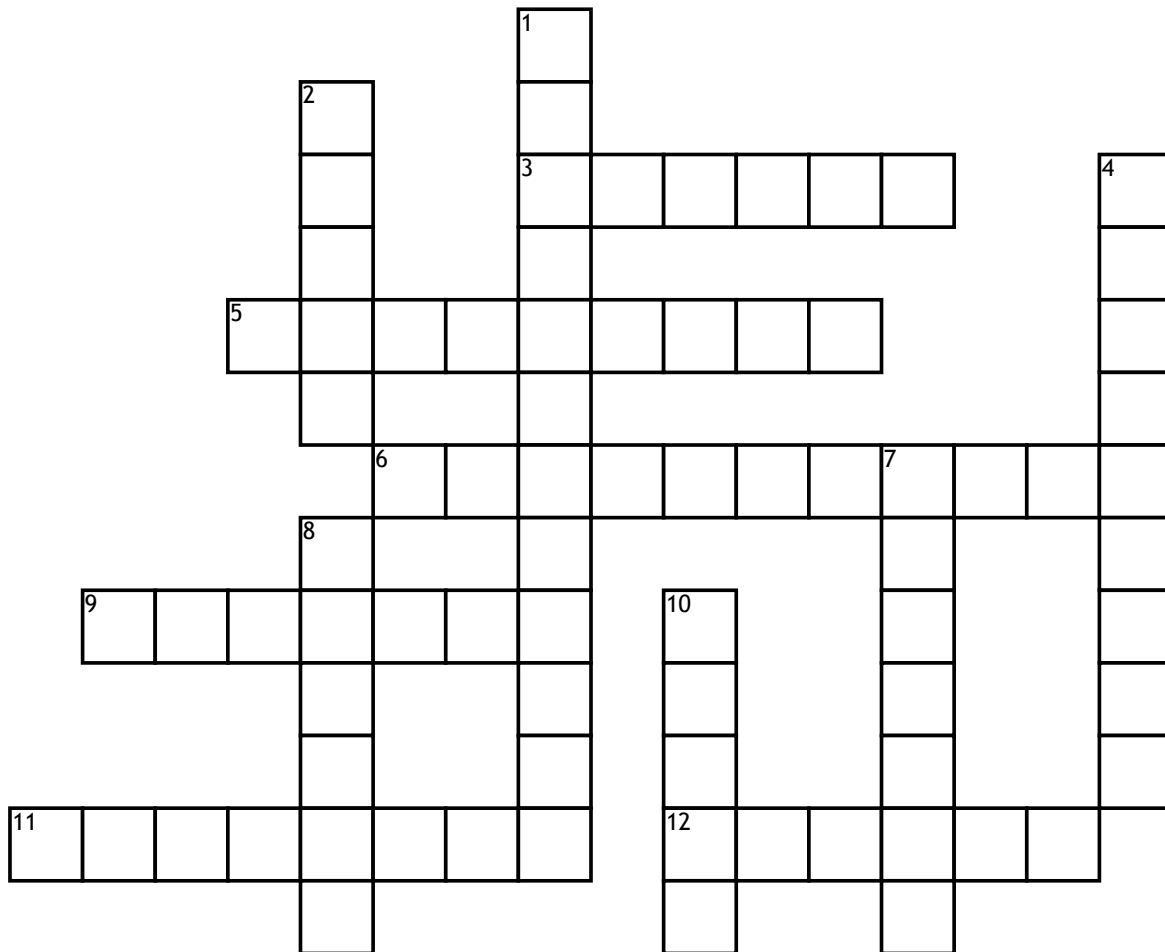


Earth's Fresh Water
