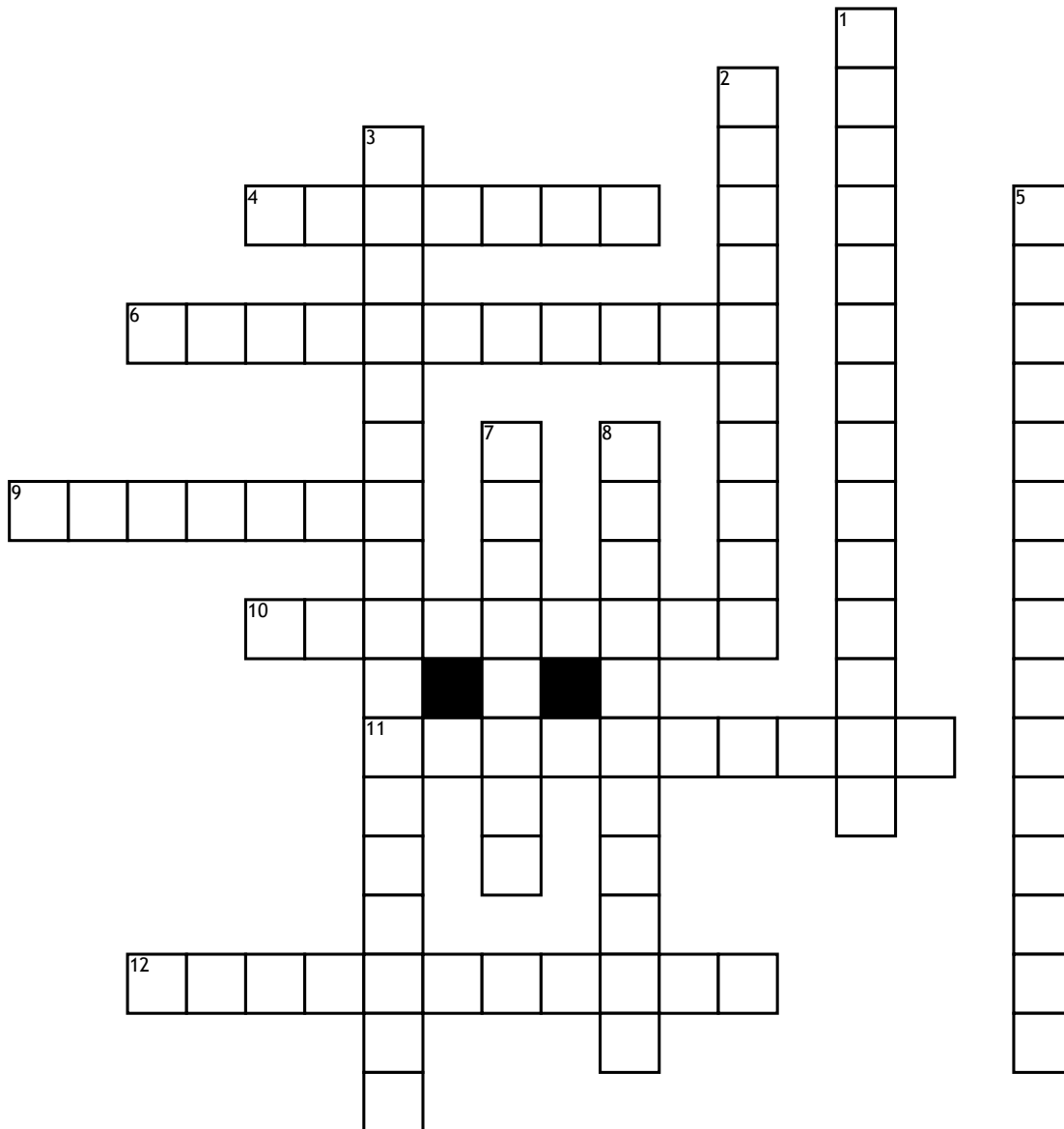


# Ecology
