

- **2.** is a literary device that is used step-by-step in literature to highlight and explain the details about a character in a story.
- **3.** is a figure of speech that makes a comparison, showing similarities between two different things.
- **5.** is a figure of speech, which presents a short story, typically with a moral lesson at the end.
- **6.** is the main idea or an underlying meaning of a literary work.

- **8.** in literature, the person who is understood to be speaking or thinking or writing a particular work.
- 11. is a brief and indirect reference to a person, place, thing or idea of historical, cultural, literary or political significance. It does not describe in detail the person or thing to which it refers.
- 13. is a line of poetry composed of trochees. A trochee is a basic metrical unit called a foot consisting of two syllables.
- **15.** is a literary device in which a part of something represents the whole, or it may use a whole to represent a part.
- **16.** is a literary device where two or more words in a phrase or line of poetry share the same beginning consonant sound.
- **18.** is a literary technique that is lyrical in nature, but not very lengthy.
- **19.** it is the mode of narration that the author employs to let the reader "hear" and "see" what takes place in a story.
