
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Egyptian Beliefs

- **7.** Son of Osiris and Nepthys; god of the dead, mummification and embalming; represented by jackel
- **10.** sister/wife of Osiris and mother to Horus; emblem that she wore was sign for throne; shown with wings
- 11. Horuss wife; goddess of love, beauty, music, joy

- **12.** King of the gods; temple at Karnak; best surviving religious complex of New Kingdom
- 15. belief in more than one god
- **16.** cat goddess; daughter of the sun god

- 1. god of the sky; represented by falcon; son of Isis and Osiris
- 2. Sun god or creator god; represented as hawk or ramhead
- 3. spiritual entity, believed to live within the body during life and to survive after death
- **4.** beetle regards as sacred by ancient Egyptians

- **5.** god who controlled the floodgates of the Nile; ram head; made humans on potter wheel out of clay
- **8.** Osiris evil brother who tried and finally succeeded in killing Osiris; god of the desert, evil and trouble
- 9. the life that follow death
- 13. One of most important gods; represented death, resurrection and fertility; ruler of the dead' shown as mummy; husband of Isis
- **14.** magical charms worn to protect owners from injury/illness
