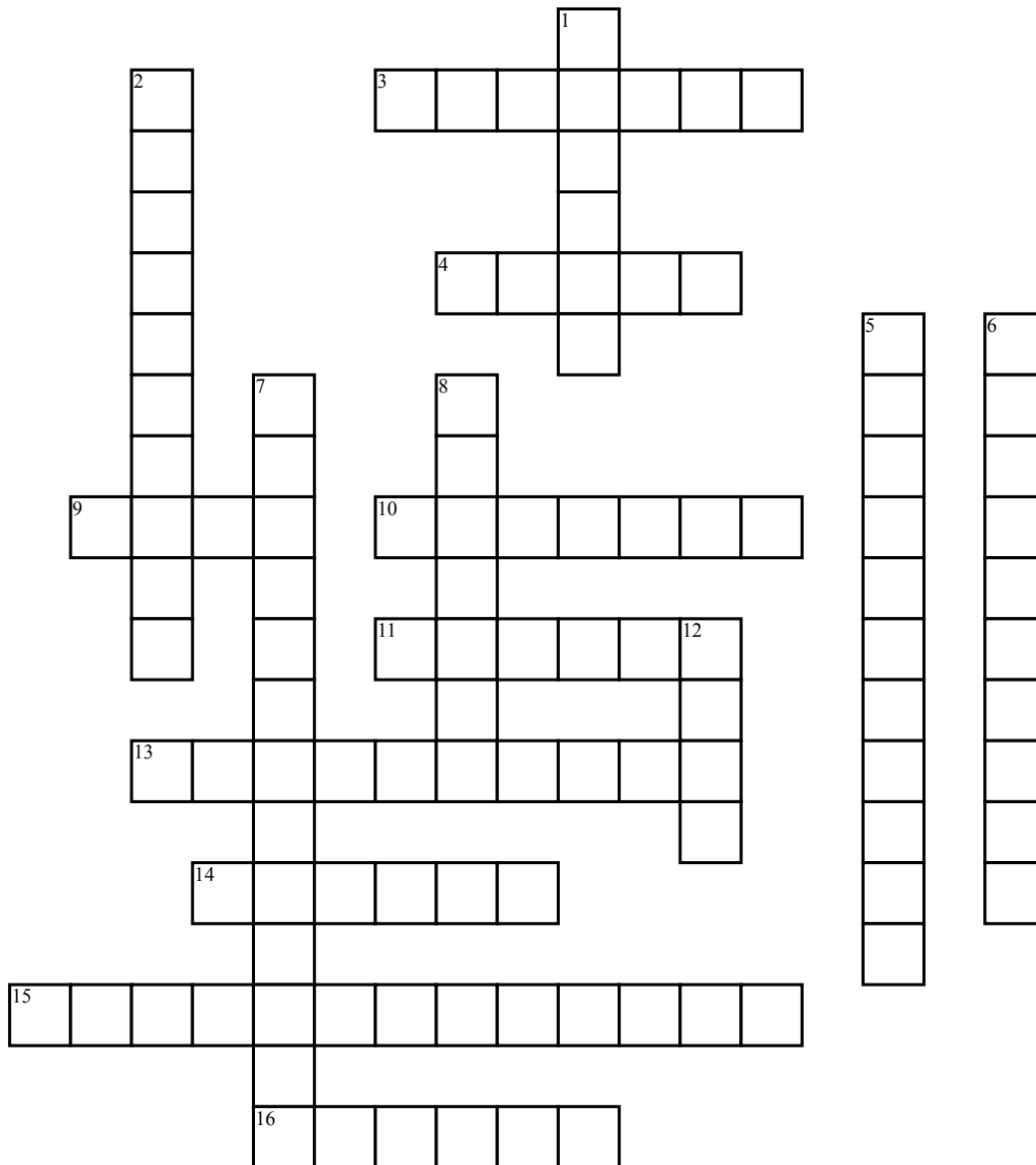


# Egyptian Crossword Puzzle
