

- 1. Shapes can either be

- 7. Line, shape, form, colour, texture, tone, space and format are all of Art
- 11. These colours are created by mixing two primary colours together
- 12. Adding white to something to make it lighter
- 13. The most basic of all the colours are known as colours. They

are red, blue and yellow.

- **14.** We get these colours when an equal amount of primary and secondary colour are mixed
- 15. This element of art is also referred to as "hue"

- 2. Colours that are opposite each other on the colour wheel
- 3. This is the area in the artwork that looks like it is closest to the front
- 4. These have height, width and depth, and can be walked around

- **5.** This refers to the type of space around an object, and not the part that takes up space
- **6.** A path created by a moving point, mark or object
- 8. A flat, enclosed area. created by lines crossing over themselves
- **9.** This is the area in the artwork that looks like it is far away
- 10. This term is applied to texture when the artist paints or draws a texture, but it is artificial
