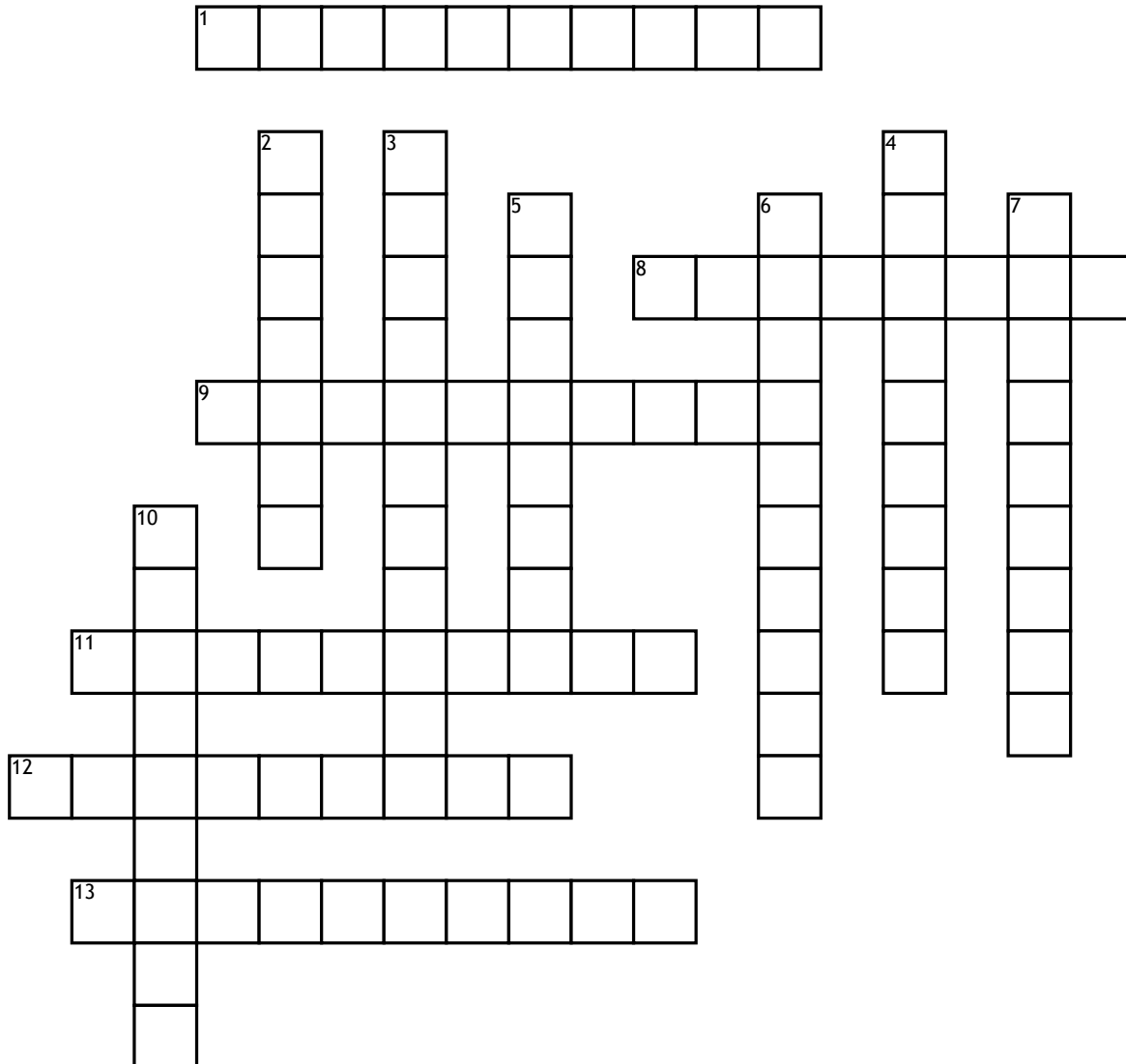


# Endocrine Medical Terms
