

- 7. Long term use can result in shrinking of the testicles and the growth of breast tissue in men. They are anabolic and increase protein within cells.
- **8.** A genetic disorder that makes XY fetuses unresponsive to androgens (male hormones). They are born looking externally like girls.
- **9.** An abnormally high concentration of parathyroid hormone in the blood, resulting in weakening of the bones through loss of calcium.
- **10.** A condition in which the body creates too much of the hormone cortisol.

- 1. A rare familial disorder that occurs in women. The adrenal glands develop abnormally and produce excess androgens which results in hormonal problems.
- **2.** An autoimmune disease that affects the thyroid.
- **3.** Deficiency of glucose in the bloodstream.
- **4.** Medical condition in which too much aldosterone is produced by the adrenal glands, which can lead to lowered levels of potassium in the blood
- **6.** An excess of glucose in the bloodstream, often associated with diabetes mellitus
