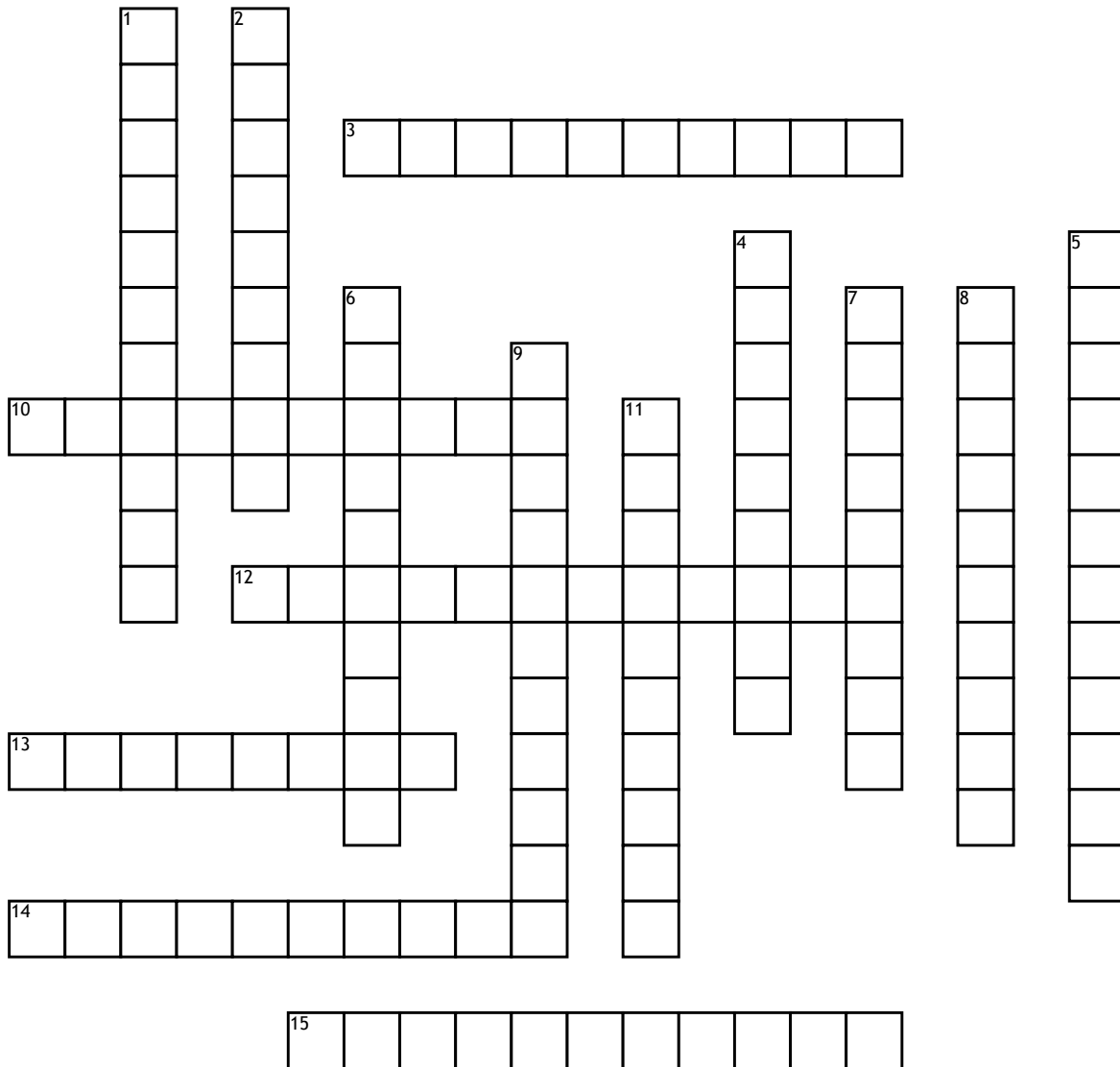


Endocrine medical terms

- 1. the tendency toward a relatively stable equilibrium between interdependent elements, especially as maintained by physiological processes
- 2. the likely course of a disease or ailment
- 4. relating to or denoting glands that secrete hormones or other products directly into the blood
- 5. lack of proper nutrition, caused by not having enough to eat, not eating enough of the right things, or being unable to use the food that one does eat

- 6. the inhibition of cell growth and multiplication
- 7. the explanation of phenomena by the purpose they serve rather than by postulated causes
- 8. A disorder in adults in which the pituitary gland produces too much growth hormone
- 9. abnormally increased appetite for food frequently associated with injury to the hypothalamus
- 11. the breakdown of glucose by enzymes, releasing energy and pyruvic acid
