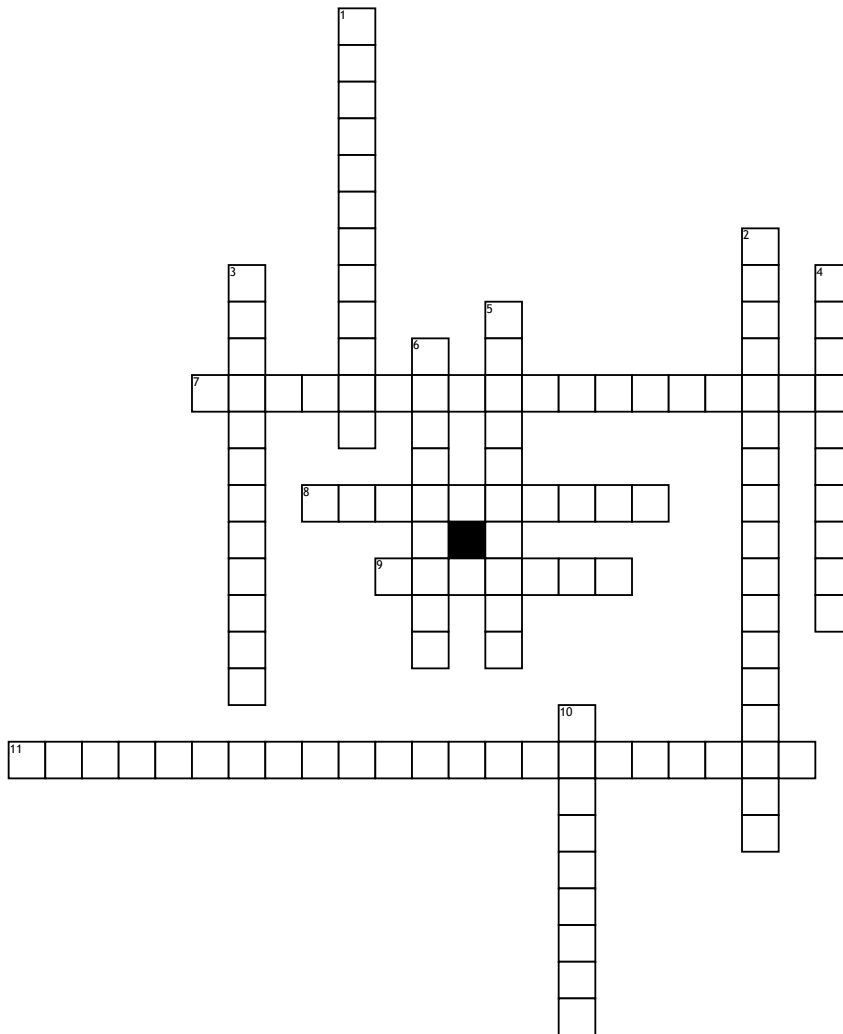


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# English Civil War Vocab

2. Rights that people are born with and cannot be taken away

3. List of rights given to the English people by William and Mary

4. English document signed in 1215; Placed clear limits on the English King (first document to do this!); could not put a man in jail without trial

5. British law-making body similar to the US Congress; majority of people in it were Puritans

6. A trial where guilt or innocence is decided by a group of peers, NOT just by a judge.
