
English policies that lead to D.O.I

- 1. 5 new taxes on the colonists passed by Parliament, all were repelled except the tax on tea.
- **2.** The King required the colonists to have British soldiers stay in their homes and feed them.
- **5.** A pamphlet written by Thomas Paine that inspired Thomas Jefferson to write the Declaration of Independence.
- **10.** The name for a problem or complaint, the colonists tried to address them with the King.
- 11. Written in 1776 by Thomas Jefferson, listed the natural rights violations of the British against the colonists and stated it was their right to overthrow them.

- **13.** As a way to protest taxes on tea, colonists dressed as native americans borded a British ship and dumped the tea into the water.
- **14.** Colonists refused to use or buy British goods as a way to protest the taxes.
- **15.** Tax on sugar the colonists had to pay to help pay for the costs of the French and Indian War.
- **16.** War between France and England in the American colonies. England won the war, they had to pay for it too.
