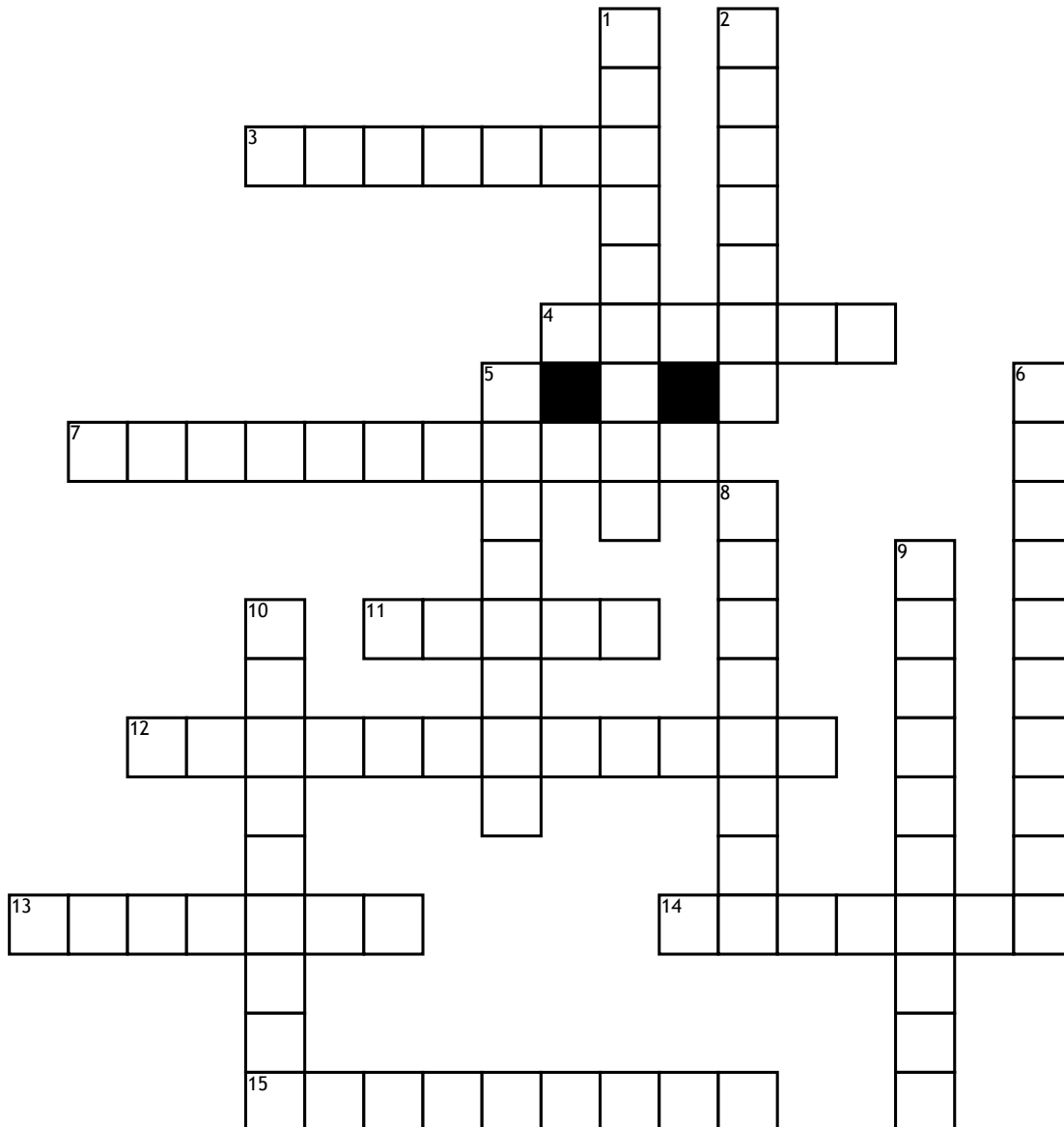


Environmental crossword.
