


# Erie Canal Crossword

9. A set of locks on the Erie Canal in Lockport, New York. It is a staircase lock constructed to lift or lower a canal boat over the Niagara Escarpment in five stages.

1. A river or man-made channel of water used for transportation.

2. A type of cloth or woven fabric, includes clothing, cotton, and fibers.

4. A person who designs, builds, or maintains engines, machines, or public works

5. A path beside a river or canal, originally used as a pathway for horses or mules towing canal boats.

8. An animal that is a mix between a horse and donkey. Canal boats had no engines or sails. They were pulled by a pair of sturdy mules horses on a towpath alongside the canal.

10. A system that helps boats that travel up or down a river or canal be moved to the next higher or lower level.
