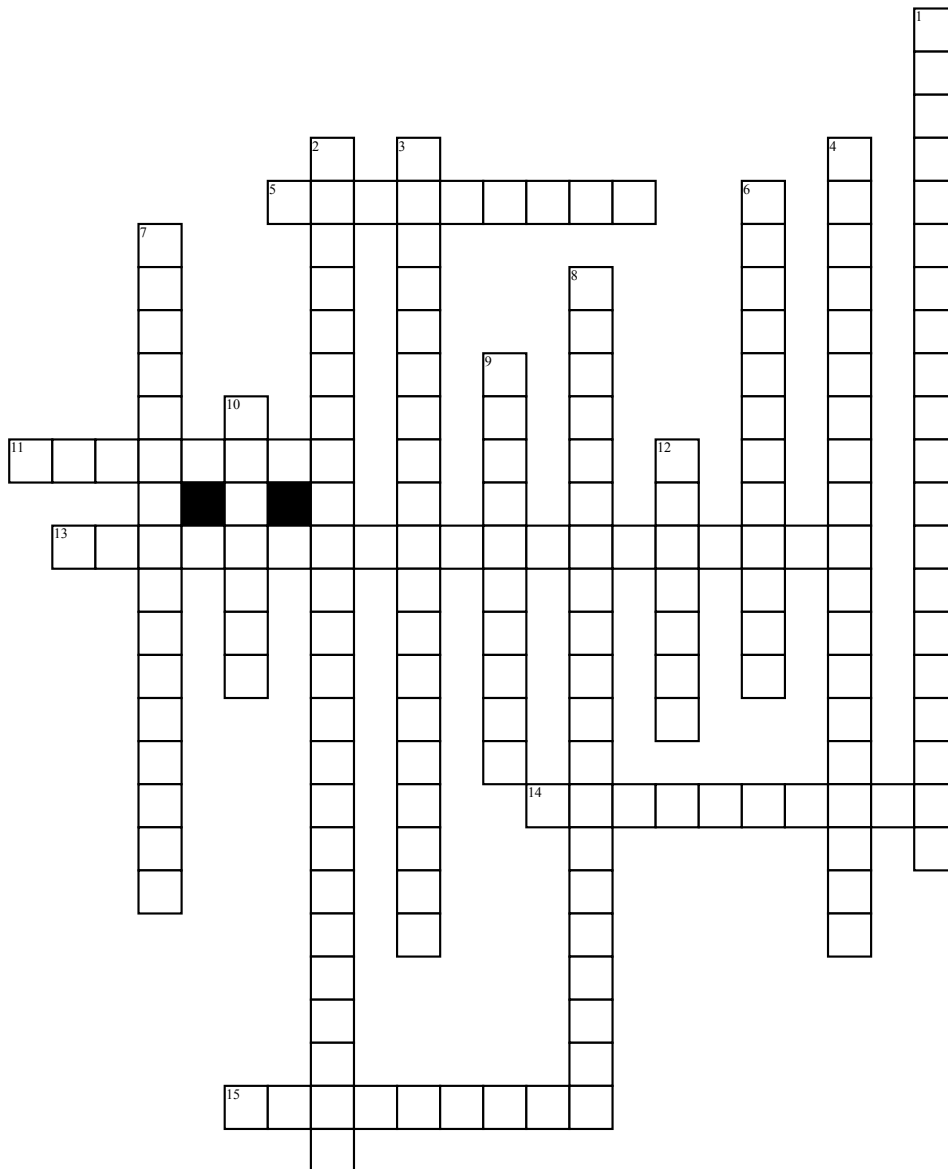


Evolution Crossword
