

- **9.** A function that adds all the numbers in a range of cells that are selected
- **11.** A group of cells going up and down in a worksheet, and are identified by letters

- **13.** A built in command which can be used to do basic mathematical functions, such as addition, multiplication, and rounding numbers
- **14.** The quantity on which an operation is to be done, or a number or cell reference used in a formula
- **15.** The mathematical rules used to find the value of a formula

- **1.** A selected cell that is bold, and ready for data entry.
- **3.** A graphic representation of values and their relationships: pie, column, line, bar

- **4.** A chart that uses bars that are of various heights to illustrate the contents of the worksheet
- **6.** A group of related worksheets
- **7.** Keep selected rows or columns visible on your screen as the other parts of the worksheet scroll down
