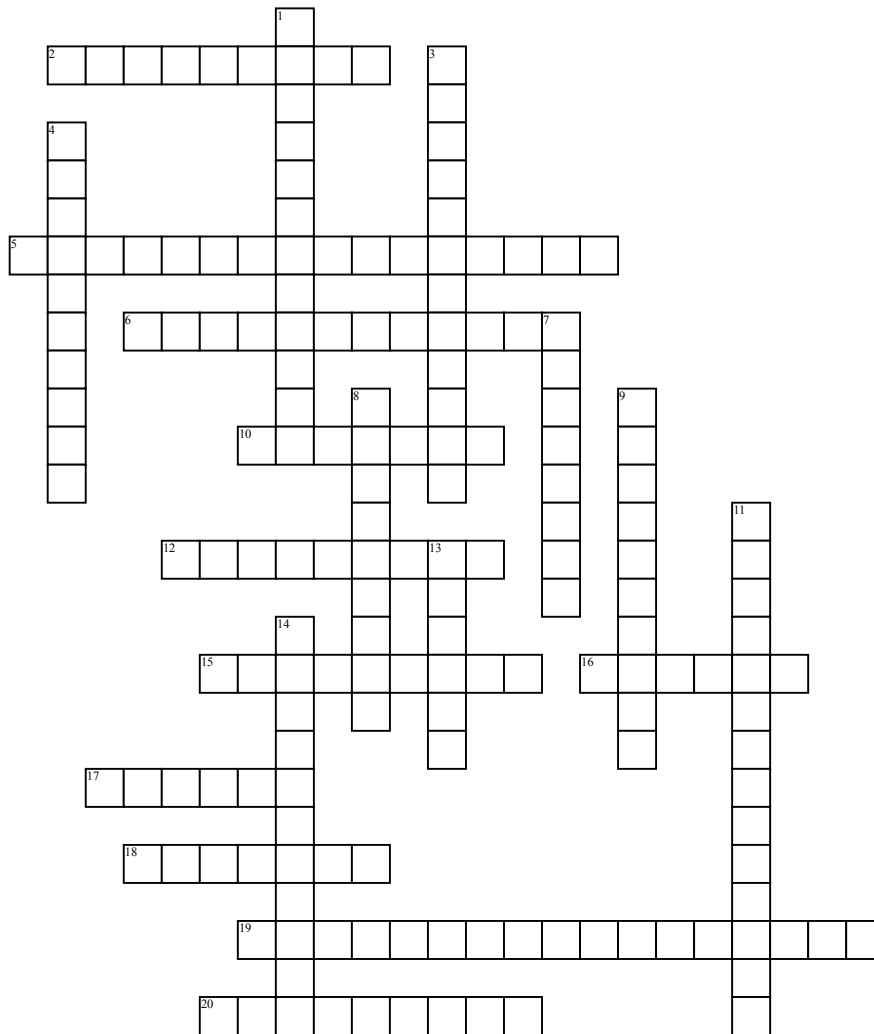


# Exploration and colonization Crossword Puzzle !
