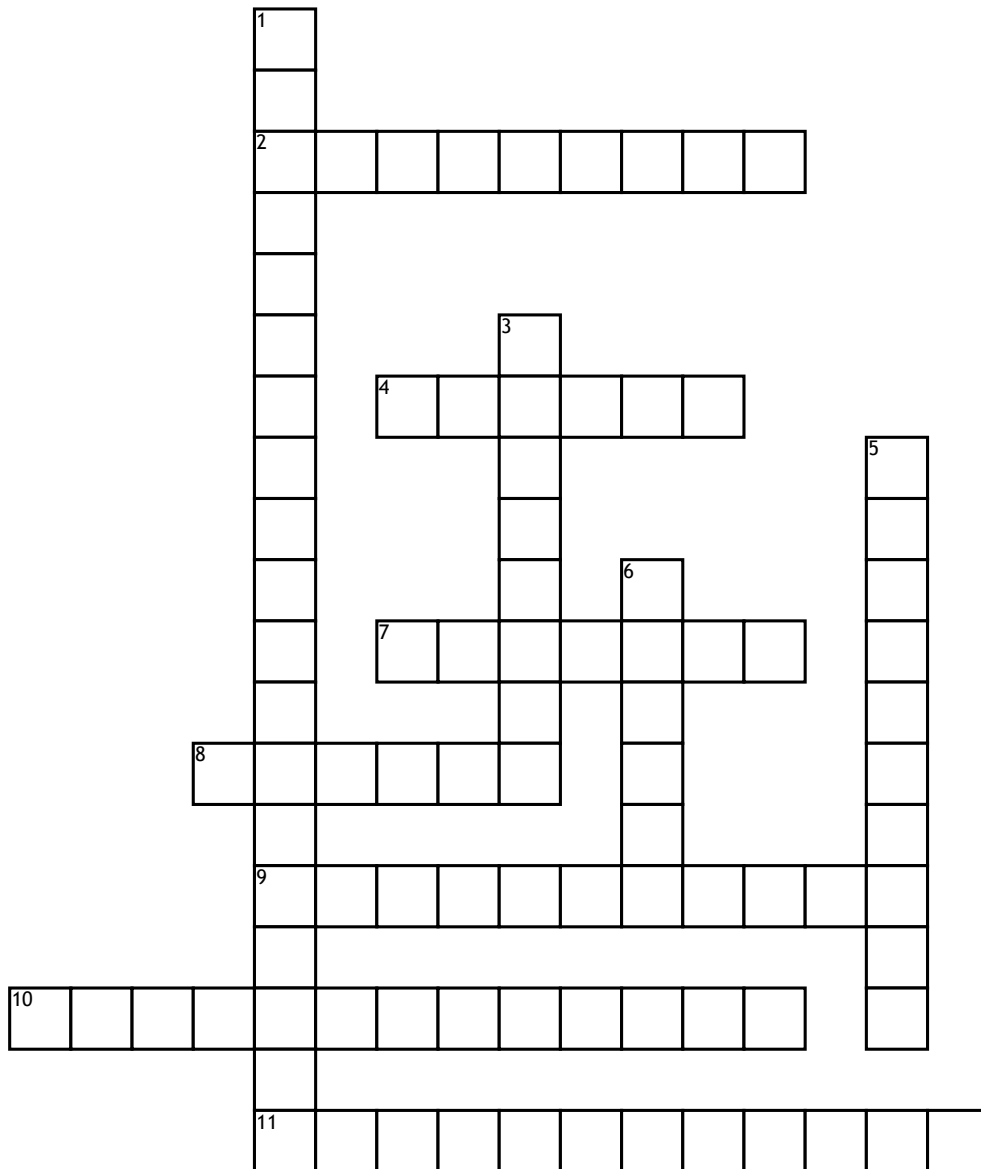

1. Light-sensing cells of the macula begin to malfunction.
