**8.** Border between the cornea and the sclera

**9.** Painful swelling at the base of eyelashes

 "Lazy eye" due to eye and brain not working together
 Location where optic nerve is attached to the retina

**15.** Blood in the anterior

chamber of the eye

16. Nearsightedness

**17.** Opacity in the lens of the eye which obstructs the passage of light

18. Light sensitive tissue lining the inner surface of the eye
19. Protrusion of the eyeball anteriorly out of the socket-usually seen with hyperthyroidism
20. Nonpainful lump in eyelid due to inflammation of gland Down

 Indicated by a yellowish disoloration of the sclera
 Clear membrane that covers the sclera and lines the inside of the eyelid
 Condition would be severed in

**3.** Condition usually caused in decreased al adults by hypertension or diabetes accomodate

**4.** Leading cause of irreversible blindness

**5.** Dye used to help visualize corneal injuries
