
FUN CATALINA FACTS

- **2.** Promotes the culture and history of Catalina Island
- **6.** This major city on Catalina Island was incorporated in 1913
- **8.** 37.85 Acres places a special emphasis on California island endemic plants
- **9.** Built in 1890 by Avalon pioneer, Peter Gano, this place sits on a hill side and has a prominent red roof and striped cupola
- **10.** Catalina Island's most recognizable landmark

- **1.** The oldest fishing club in the United States, founded in 1898
- 3. Former home of William Wrigley Jr.
- **4.** In 1926 this American author built a pueblo-style home on the sunny hillside overlooking Avalon Bay
- **5.** The official name of boat terminal, this place acts both as a breakwater and the main docks for the cross-channel passenger boats
- **7.** Presented as a gift to the town of Avalon by Mrs. Ada Wrigley, built in 1925
