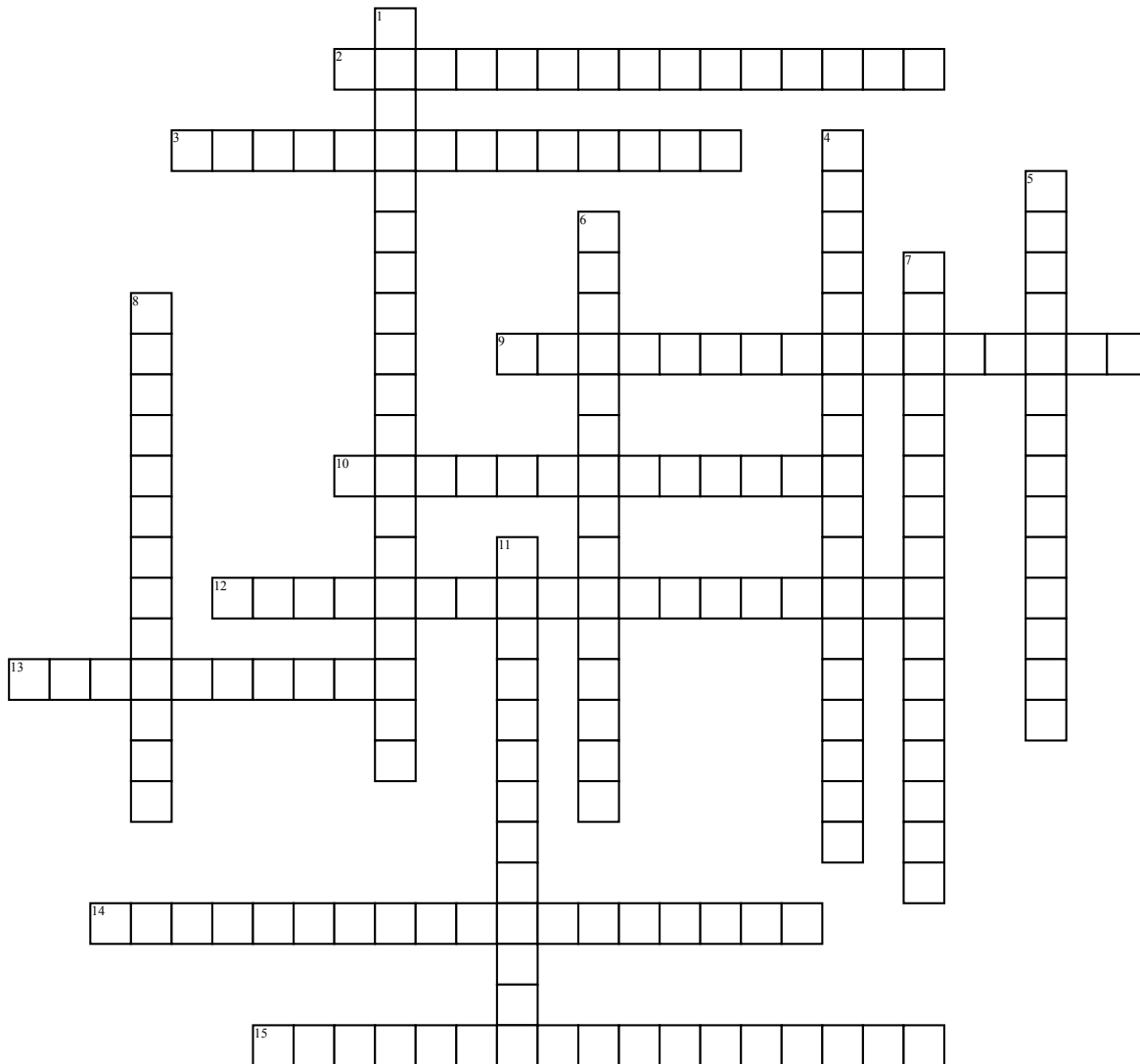

Famous Battles Won by Allies

2. From April 1st to June 22nd, 1945. It was a series of battles fought in the Japanese Ryukyu Island. Allies were USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, etc. There were against Empire of Japan

9. December 16, 1944 - January 25, 1945. This battle was fought through the very forested Ardennes region of Wallonia. This was a surprise attack on Allied forces by Germany, this was a battle between the U.S, France, Canada, Belgium, Britain, and Luxembourg versus Germany.

10. January 9 - August 15, 1945. This battle was a planned attack by the Allies. It took place on the shore line of the Philippines. The U.S, Commonwealth of the Philippines, Australia, and Mexico battled against Japan and Second Philippines Republic. The Japanese unconditionally surrendered.

12. From 7th August 1942 to 9th February 1943, in Guadalcanal in the Solomon Islands. The Allies were USA, Australia, New Zealand, etc. Against the Empire of Japan. This was the first major offensive and a decisive victory for the Allies in the Pacific theater. US marine launched a surprise attack and took control of an air base under construction.

13. From March 7th to April 21, 1945, at Ruhr area, Germany. Allies were USA, Britain against Nazi Germany. The Allies crossed the Rhine River, South of the Ruhr under General Omar Nelson Bradley. The battle marked the end of major organized resistance on Nazi Germany's Western Front, as more than 300,000 troops were taken prisoner.

14. From June 6 to July 24, 1944 at the Northern coast of France. Allies were USA & Britain & Canada & Norway & ect against Germany and Italy. The battle begun with overnight parachute and glider landings, massive air attacks and naval bombardments

15. October 23 - October 26, 1944. This was named the largest naval battle of WW2. It took place in the Philippine waters. It was fought between the U.S and Australia versus Japan. The United States had invaded the Philippine islands to isolate Japan from other countries.

1. September 3, 1939 - May 8, 1945 this battle was the longest battle in WW2 continuing from the beginning of the war to the end. The Kriegsmarine and the Luftwaffe fought against the Royal Canadian Navy, Royal Navy, and the United States Navy. This battle took place in the ocean.

4. From April 6 to May 2, 1945 in northern Italy. It was the final Allied attack during the Italy Campaign in the final stage of the second World War. Allies were USA, Italy, Brazil, United Kingdom, etc. against Nazi Germany and Italian Social Republic.

5. February 3 - March 3, 1945. This battle was the end of the Japanese military rule. The United States and Commonwealth of the Philippines battled Japan and the Second Philippine Republic. It was fought in the capital of the capital of the Philippines. This was a planned attack by the Allies.

6. From 3rd to 17th of September, 1943, in Salerno, Calabria and Toronto, Italy. It was a battle in the beginning if the Italian Campaign WW2. Allies were USA, Canada and United Kingdom against Nazi Germany and Italy (to September 8th 1943)

7. From March 24th, 1945 in Wesel, Germany. Allies were USA, Canada, Britain against Nazi Germany. It was part of Operation Plunder assault under Field Marshal Montgomery to cross the northern Rhine River and from there enter Northern Germany. The assault troops secure a foothold across the Rhine River in Western Germany by landing two airborne divisions on the eastern bank of the Rhine

8. August 7 - September 19, 1944. Britain and the United States against Germany. This battle is considered one of the fiercest battles on the western front. This was part of the Allied plan for invading Europe's mainland to get supplies to Allied forces.

11. January 22 - June 5, 1944. The United States, Britain, and Canada battle Germany and the Italian Social Republic. This battle took place in Italy. The Allies were planning to attack when they were surprise attacked by Germany and Italy. They were stuck and had to change Generals. When they did the new General got them to fight out and eventually captured Rome.
