

8. An eccentric German composer that wrote very moving orchestra pieces, such as the Twilight of the Gods.
9. The famous piano prodigy in the 19th century, known for creating graceful pieces such as Prelude and Nocturne.
10. A traditional pianist that wrote Intermezzo, Hungarian Dances and A German Requiem among many other pieces.

1. The Russian composer of Swan Lake, Sleeping Beauty and the Nutcracker.
3. A German composer in the late 1700's to the early 1800's that created Fur Elise, Moonlight Sonata and Pastoral Symphony.
5. A Parisian composer very known for their dreamy music, their most famous piece being La Mer
6. The Finnish composer of Karelia Suite, En Saga and Tulen Synty
7. A Hungarian pianist beloved in their time, writing over a thousand piano pieces, some of the most well known being Dante Symphony and Liebestraum
