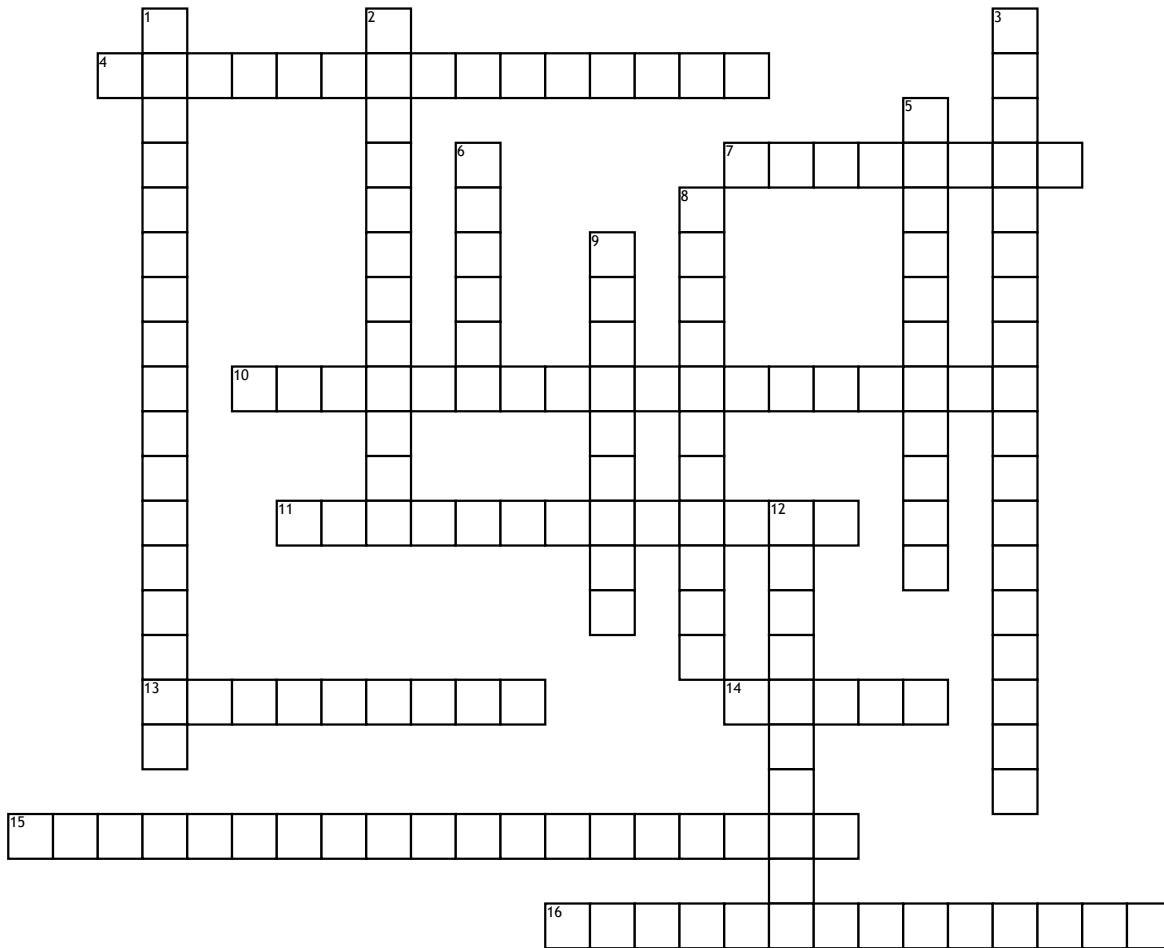


Famous sites around the world crossword

4. This huge landmark sits on an Island in New York Harbor. It was a dedication from the French to the Americans as a symbol of friendship in 1886.

7. This is a beautiful mausoleum in India built from white marble. It was built in 1632 by the emperor Shah Jahan as a tomb for his favourite wife.

10. This is a monument connected to a cathedral in Italy. Its name comes from the tilt of the building.

11. This is the official home and workplace of the President of the United States in Washington DC. It has housed every president since 1800. ('The' is needed)

13. This structure in Australia is believed to be about 700 million years old. Its official name is Uluru and is very special to indigenous Australians.

14. This holy city is in Saudi Arabia. It is very important to Muslims as it is the birthplace of their prophet Muhammad. Millions of Muslims visit every year for the pilgrimage.

15. This is nearly 14,000 miles long and was built more than 2300 years ago. The Chinese emperors built it to protect the city. ('The' is needed)

16. This is a large human-headed lion carved from limestone. It sits on the bank of the river Nile in Egypt where it guards a pyramid. ('The' is needed)

1. This is an extremely colourful church in Moscow in Russia. It was built from 1551 to 1561. (The apostrophe does not have its own square)

2. This very beautiful building is in Amritsar in India. It is the holiest temple for Sikhs and was built in 1604.

3. This is the largest and oldest Egyptian pyramid. It is believed to have been built for the pharaoh Khufu by 2560BC.

5. This is a 15th Century Inca site in Peru in South America. It is high in the Andes Mountains, 2430 meters above sea level!

6. This is the nickname for the clock tower of the Palace of Westminster in London.

8. This is a very popular landmark in Paris built in 1889, it is 324 meters tall.

9. 3. An oval Amphitheatre in the middle of Rome, built in 80 AD. It is the largest Amphitheatre ever built.

12. A prehistoric monument in Wiltshire believed to have been constructed from 3000 BC to 2000 BC.
