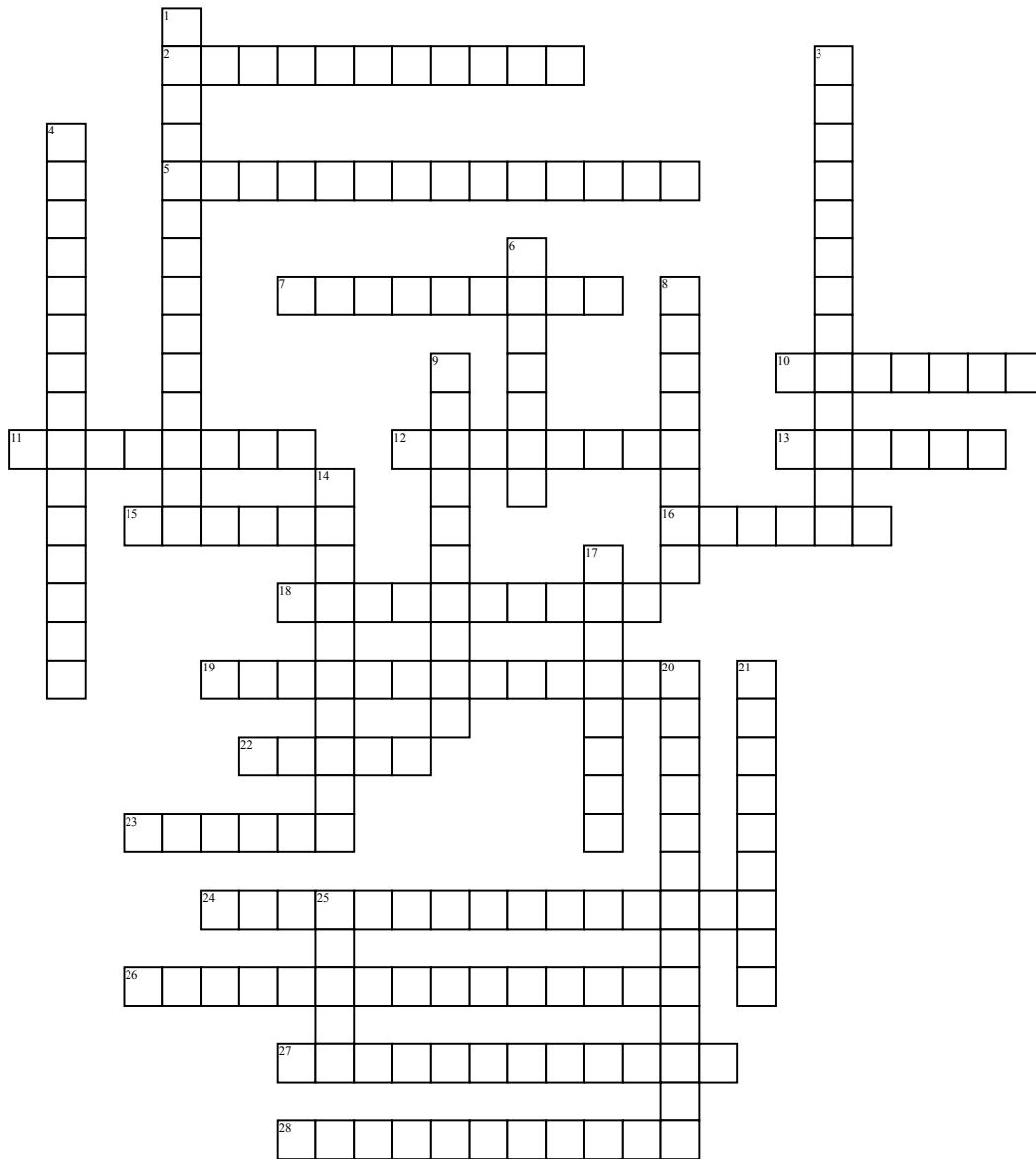


Fianl Exam Crossword Puzzle
