

- 7. A fictional story that takes place in a particular time period in the PAST; often the setting is real, but the characters are made up from the author's imagination.
- **8.** A suspenseful story about a puzzling event; the problem is solved by following clues
- **9.** Stories passed down from one generation to the next orally by different CULTURAL groups.
- **10.** Similar to folktales, but the characters are animals, and there is a moral or lesson.

- 11. Stories that are related to explain historical events and describe historical figures from a specific time or place (EX: Robin Hood)
- 12. A make-believe story including elements that are impossible in real life, such as talking animals or magical powers.

- **1.** A fantasy story that uses science and technology.
- 2. Stories that are passed down from one group to another throughout history (folktales, tall tales, fairy tales, legends, fables, myths)

- **3.** A story using made-up characters that could actually happen in REAL life.
- **4.** Similar to folktales, they have roots in the oral tradition; they also include magical elements (EX: Cinderella)
- **5.** Stories based on tradition to explain how the world and humankind came to be.
- **6.** Originated from American folk stories with unbelievable elements told as if they were TRUE.
