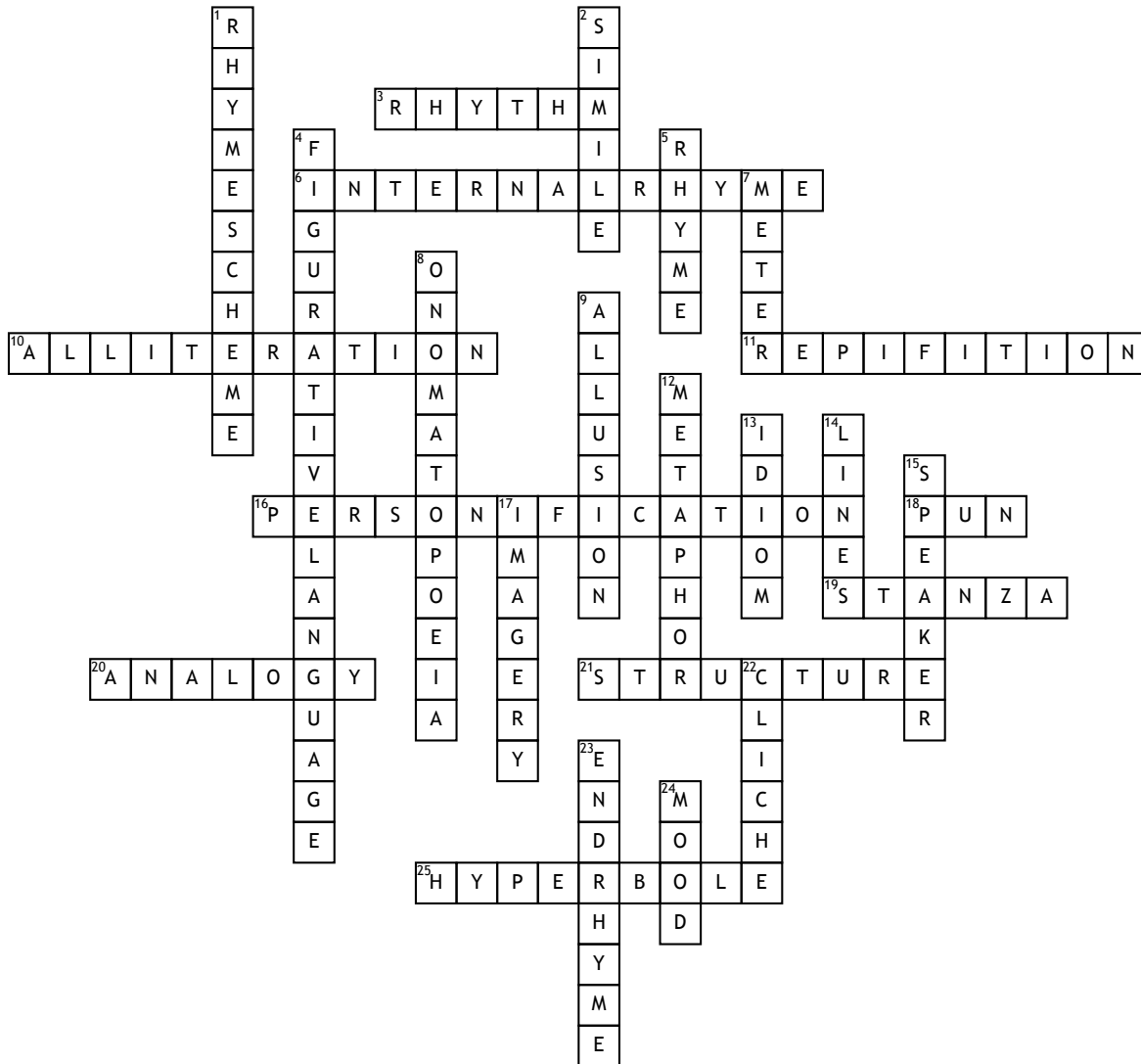


Figurative Language Crossword Puzzle
