

5. Sometimes called a baby bonus to help Canadians raise their children
7. Period of worldwide economic collapse in the 1930's, caused by many hardships and changed the people's ideas about the role of government.
9. Was passed in 1966 by the federal government which helped fund provincial health-care programs
10. A collective journey to take their demands to the federal government. (Asked for fair wages, seven- hour work day, etc)

1. Has a variety of government programs--sometimes called social security or a social safety net--to ensure all citizens have a minimum standard of living.
2. Supported the idea that everyone should share in the profits from their labour
3. A bill passed in 1960 that guaranteed Canadians to the right of life, liberty, personal security, and enjoyment of property, etc.
4. Prime minister at the start of the Great Depression
